Commissioner Skop requested staff to contact Progress Energy concerning making a presentation at an Internal Affairs Meeting on their Mariculture Program and how these conservation efforts might be used to restore/replenish the estuaries/fisheries on the Nature Coast and the Big Bend area. Commissioner Skop requested that the presentation include highlights of the program; in light of the recent oil spill in the Gulf, what may happen to the fisheries; and if they have the ability to do other things to help the environment.

- b. Commissioner Skop advised that the Nuclear Waste Strategy Coalition conducted a conference call today. One of the issues discussed was the Yucca Mountain Licensing Proceeding. Cindy Miller advised that an Amicus Memorandum has been filed in the NRC proceeding concerning the closing of the Yucca Mountain Proceeding.

In the case concerning the Nuclear Waste Fund, the NRC has filed an answer to the Commission's Motion to Participate as Amicus Curiae, they do not oppose the Motion. Cindy Miller advised that a briefing schedule has not been established yet, but that she has spoken with the U. S. Court of Appeals, and the Commission should be receiving the schedule soon.
