ON YOUR LOCAL PHONE SERVICE

The **Lifeline Assistance** program offers a **\$9.25** credit on qualified residential customers' local monthly phone bills and broadband.

Making telephone service affordable to low-income consumers in our state.

You may be eligible for savings if you receive benefits under one of these programs:

- ◆ Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- ◆ Medicaid
- ◆ Federal Public Housing Assistance (Section 8)
- ◆ Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
- ◆ Veterans Pension and Survivors Benefit
- ◆ Bureau of Indian Affairs Programs
- ◆ Tribal Temporary Assistance for Needy Families
- ◆ Head Start Subsidy
- ◆ National School Lunch Program (NSLP)

If you are at or below 135% of the poverty level, but not currently receiving benefits from one of the listed programs, you may be able to qualify by contacting the Office of Public Counsel in Tallahassee at 1-800-540-7039.

Some wireless and competitive local exchange companies (CLECs) also offer the Lifeline Assistance program.
