Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) requests confidential classification of certain information provided in response to staff's first supplemental data request in the review of FPL's 2018 Ten-Year Site Plan. Specifically, FPL requests confidentiality of the highlighted sections of its responses to question numbers 62 and 65 under Section 366.093(3)(d), F.S.: "Information concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the public utility or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms," and Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S.: "Information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information."

The highlighted information in response to question numbers 62 and 65 can be described as information related to FPL's contractual agreement with a particular vendor for services required to implement the U.S. Environment Protection Agency's Coal-Combustion Residual Rule. Staff has reviewed the information FPL has filed, as well as its confidentiality request, and believes the information that is the subject of the request meets the criteria for confidentiality under the sections requested.
