2 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Item No. -- No. 17.

3 MR. DOHERTY: Good morning, Commissioners.
4 I'm Riley Doherty with Commission staff.

5 Item 17 is Tampa Electric's petition for
6 approval of its revised underground residential
7 distribution tariffs. Tariffs provide standard
8 charges for underground service in new residential
9 subdivisions and represents the additional costs,
10 if any, the utility incurs to provide underground
11 service in place of overhead service. TECO's
12 proposed underground differential for low-density
13 and high-density subdivisions is zero dollars.

14 Staff has reviewed Tampa Electric's proposed
15 distribution tariffs as well as the company's
16 response to staff's data request. We believe the
17 proposed tariffs are reasonable and recommend
18 Commission approval.

19 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Thank you, staff.

20 Commissioner Polmann?

21 COMMISSIONER POLMANN: Mr. Doherty, do we have
22 information from other utilities that the
23 underground-installation costs have generally
24 decreased or is this the first evidence that --
25 that you have?

1 MR. DOHERTY: At this time, we don't have
2 other utilities' information; just -- Tampa's is
3 the only one at this moment.

4 COMMISSIONER POLMANN: Okay. Thank you, sir.

5 MR. DOHERTY: Yes, sir.

6 COMMISSIONER POLMANN: Mr. Chairman, I would
7 move approval of all issues here.

8 COMMISSIONER BROWN: Second.

9 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: It's been moved and second,
10 approval of staff recommendations on Item No. 17.
11 Is there any further discussion?

12 Seeing none, all in favor, say aye.

13 (Chorus of ayes.)

14 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Any opposed?

15 By your action, you have approved staff rec on
16 Item No. 17.

17 Staff, thank you very much.
