- c. Notify customers of the availability of the service, using a notice similar to the one shown in Attachment III of staff's memorandum dated March 17, 1989. The notice should be submitted for staff review prior to mailing.

Southern Bell should be required to do the above for the intraLATA Newberry to Trenton route.

Issue: 2. Recommendation that the companies be required to file reports eight months after implementation, for the first six months' provision of service, showing the following:

1. The frequency of calling to each designated toll-free number, by exchange of origination.
2. The amount of lost toll revenues associated with provision of the service, by designated toll-free telephone number and by exchange of origination.
3. The costs of providing the service.
4. A summary of any correspondence, complaints, or comments of customers regarding the service.

Staff will use the reports to determine customer acceptance and the impact on the companies of implementing the plan, so that the viability of the plan for similar future cases can be gauged.

Issue: 3. Recommendation that the docket remain open and the process for evaluating the possible implementation of a toll alternative in this docket should continue as scheduled.

I am writing on behalf of MCI Telecommunications Corporation (MCI) to express MCI's concerns with concept of "county seat calling" that is under consideration by the Commission in Docket Nos. 870790-TL and 870248-TL.

As we understand the concept, residents of some exchanges would be allowed to call specific telephone numbers in the county seat (such as county government offices) on a toll free basis. MCI could be affected by county seat calling wherever MCI provides originating service in an exchange that is entitled to toll free service, and a call to the county seat crosses an EAEA or LATA boundary. We understand that this situation may exist along some proposed routes in the Holmes County docket.

MCI has two types of concerns about the county seat calling concept. First, from a policy viewpoint, MCI believes that it is inappropriate to provide toll free interEAEA or interLATA service, except in very limited circumstances in which EAS is warranted. If county governments or others desire a service whereby callers can avoid toll charges, there are ample alternatives currently available in the form of FX or 800 service. Those alternatives can be easily implemented without creating any potential discrimination, and without any adverse impact on other ratepayers.

Second, from a practical viewpoint, MCI cannot fully implement county seat calling except in exchanges where billing service is obtained from the LEC, and the LEC can remove affected calls from the long distance portion of the bill. Where MCI bills customers directly, its current billing system does not have the capability to automatically remove calls to specific numbers from selected customers' bills. Thus in the one other state (Tennessee) in which MCI has been faced with a concept similar to county seat calling, MCI has had to rely on making after-the-fact billing adjustments when a customer notifies a customer service representative that he or she has been billed for a call to a number that is supposed to be toll free. While this system partially addresses the problem, it places MCI at a competitive disadvantage vis-a-vis other carriers that use LEC billing services and can offer "automatic" credit on their customers' bills.

MCI's inability to automatically remove selected calls from customers' bills is due to limitations in MCI's centralized, nationwide billing system. Given the extremely small percentage of MCI's total traffic volume that would be represented by toll free calls, it is not technically or economically feasible both to develop the software and to commit the computer processor resources that would be necessary to attempt to implement county seat calling directly in MCI's billing system.

Based on these policy and practical considerations, MCI urges the Commission not to implement county seat calling. In the event that the Commission determines that county seat calling deserves further consideration, MCI believes that all affected parties should be afforded an opportunity for a hearing at which these and other related issues could be fully explored.



REQUEST OF BELL SOUTH CORPORATION FOR A WAIVER
OF THE MODIFICATION OF FINAL JUDGMENT TO IMPLEMENT
A TWO-WAY, \$.25 PER MESSAGE EXTENDED AREA SERVICE ("EAS")
PLAN BETWEEN THE TRENTON TO BRANFORD, TRENTON TO HIGH SPRINGS,
NEWBERRY TO BRANFORD, AND NEWBERRY TO TRENTON EXCHANGES
IN GILCHRIST AND LEVY COUNTIES, FLORIDA

Pursuant to Order No. 25340 of the Florida Public Service Commission,¹ BellSouth Corporation, on behalf of Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company ("Southern Bell"), submits the following request for a waiver of the Decree to the Department of Justice for presentation to the Court.

Southern Bell seeks a waiver to provide a two-way, \$.25 Per Message Extended Area Service ("EAS") Plan over four interLATA routes in Gilchrist and Levy Counties, Florida. The interLATA routes are between (1) Southern Bell's Trenton and ALLTEL Florida, Inc.'s ("ALLTEL") Branford exchanges; (2) Southern Bell's Trenton and ALLTEL's High Springs exchanges; (3) Southern Bell's Newberry and ALLTEL's Branford exchanges; and (4) Southern Bell's Newberry

and Trenton exchanges. The Newberry and Trenton exchanges are located in the Gainesville LATA and the Branford and High Springs exchanges are located in the Jacksonville LATA.²

The Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") has issued a notice of proposed agency action accepting a settlement agreement between the Board of County Commissioners of Gilchrist County, Southern Bell and ALLTEL for the purpose of requiring implementation of EAS throughout Gilchrist County. After reviewing the facts and circumstances of the case, the Commission found it reasonable and appropriate to approve the settlement agreement in its entirety.

The Commission further ordered that Southern Bell seek a waiver of the Decree to carry the traffic on the affected interLATA routes and that the Plan be implemented by July 1, 1992. See Order No. 25340 at p. 3.

For the foregoing reasons, BellSouth requests that the Department of Justice concur in this request and move for an Order of the Court permitting Southern Bell to implement the two-way, \$.25 per message EAS Plan between Southern Bell's Trenton and ALLTEL's Branford exchanges; Southern Bell's Trenton and ALLTEL's High Springs exchanges; Southern Bell's Newberry and ALLTEL's

Branford exchanges; and Southern Bell's Newberry and Trenton exchanges.

NOTICE OF PROPOSED AGENCY ACTION
ORDER ACCEPTING SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

BY THE COMMISSION:

NOTICE is hereby given by the Florida Public Service Commission that the action discussed herein is preliminary in nature and will become final unless a person whose interests are adversely affected files a petition for a formal proceeding, pursuant to Rule 25-22.029, Florida Administrative Code.

This docket was initiated in response to a resolution filed with this Commission by the Gilchrist County Board of County Commissioners (Gilchrist County). This resolution requested that we consider requiring implementation of extended area service (EAS) throughout Gilchrist County. Four exchanges are affected by this request: Branford, High Springs, Newberry, and Trenton. The Branford and High Springs exchanges are served by ALLTEL Florida, Inc. (ALLTEL), while the Newberry and Trenton exchanges are served by Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company (Southern Bell). In addition to involving intercompany routes, this request also involves interLATA (local access transport area) routes. The Branford and High Springs exchanges are located in the Jacksonville LATA, while the Newberry and Trenton exchanges are located in the Gainesville LATA. Not one of the four exchanges is located exclusively in Gilchrist County.

There has been a substantial amount of activity in this docket since it was first opened in 1987. A review of that history can be found in Orders Nos. 23856 and 24752 and will not be repeated here. Because Gilchrist County had protested our proposal to deny any further EAS in the county, this matter was set for hearing on July 17, 1991, in Bell, Florida. Subsequently, it came to our attention that a number of parties to the docket had entered into negotiations with the goal of resolving all of the issues presented by Gilchrist County's petition. In an attempt to facilitate these

efforts, we cancelled the scheduled hearing to allow the parties to continue their negotiations.

Subsequently, an agreement was reached between Gilchrist County, ALLTEL, and Southern Bell. The operative portions of this agreement are set forth below:

1. Southern Bell agrees to charge a local message rate of \$.25 per call regardless of the call duration for calls made between Southern Bell's Trenton exchange and Newberry exchange and to treat such calls as local calls.

2. ALLTEL agrees to charge a local message rate of \$.25 per call regardless of the call duration for calls made between ALLTEL's High Springs exchange and Branford exchange and to treat such calls as local calls.

3. Southern Bell will not object to the Commission ordering a local message rate of \$.25 per call to be applied to calls which are currently transported over a LATA boundary from the Trenton exchange to the High Springs or Branford exchange or over a LATA boundary from the Newberry exchange to the Branford exchange. ALLTEL will not object to the Commission ordering a local message rate of \$.25 per call to be applied to calls which are currently transported over a LATA boundary from the High Springs or Branford exchanges to Trenton exchange or over LATA boundary from the Branford exchange to the Newberry exchange. All parties recognize that Southern Bell's ability to provide such service is contingent upon obtaining appropriate relief of the court having jurisdiction over the Modification of Final Judgment ("MFJ"). Southern Bell agrees to use due diligence in seeking a waiver of the MFJ restrictions. The existing rates and services between the Newberry and High Springs exchanges shall remain in effect.

4. It is the intent of Southern Bell and ALLTEL to implement the \$.25 local message rate, if so ordered by the Commission, by July 1, 1992.

5. Southern Bell will discontinue all its Enhanced Optional Extended Area Service ("EOEAS") options in Gilchrist County with the exception of the EOEAS premium

option. Notwithstanding the foregoing, Southern Bell's EOEAS options will continue to be offered to customers in the Trenton exchange for calls made between the Trenton exchange and the Gainesville exchange. All other existing local rates in Gilchrist County will remain in effect. The parties agree that this Agreement shall not preclude ALLTEL, Southern Bell or Gilchrist County from requesting rate relief in the future for any rates associated with the exchanges in Gilchrist County.

6. The parties agree that this Agreement shall not have precedential value for other proceedings and has been entered into solely for the purpose of resolving all disputes regarding the provision of EAS in Gilchrist County.

Upon review of the facts and circumstances surrounding this case, we find it reasonable and appropriate to approve the negotiated settlement agreement in its entirety. Accordingly, calls between Branford and High Springs, Branford and Newberry, Branford and Trenton, High Springs and Trenton, and Newberry and Trenton shall be rated at \$.25 per call, regardless of call duration. These calls shall be furnished on a seven-digit basis. Calls at pay telephones shall be treated as local for both end users and pay telephone providers. ALLTEL and Southern Bell shall implement this calling plan no later than July 1, 1992. Southern Bell shall immediately begin seeking a waiver of the Modified Final Judgment to allow it to carry the traffic on the affected routes.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that the settlement agreement entered into by the Board of County Commissioners of Gilchrist County, Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company, and ALLTEL Florida, Incorporated for the purpose of resolving the issues in this docket is hereby approved in its entirety. It is further

ORDERED that if no proper protest is filed within the time frame set forth below, our proposed action shall become final and this docket shall be closed.

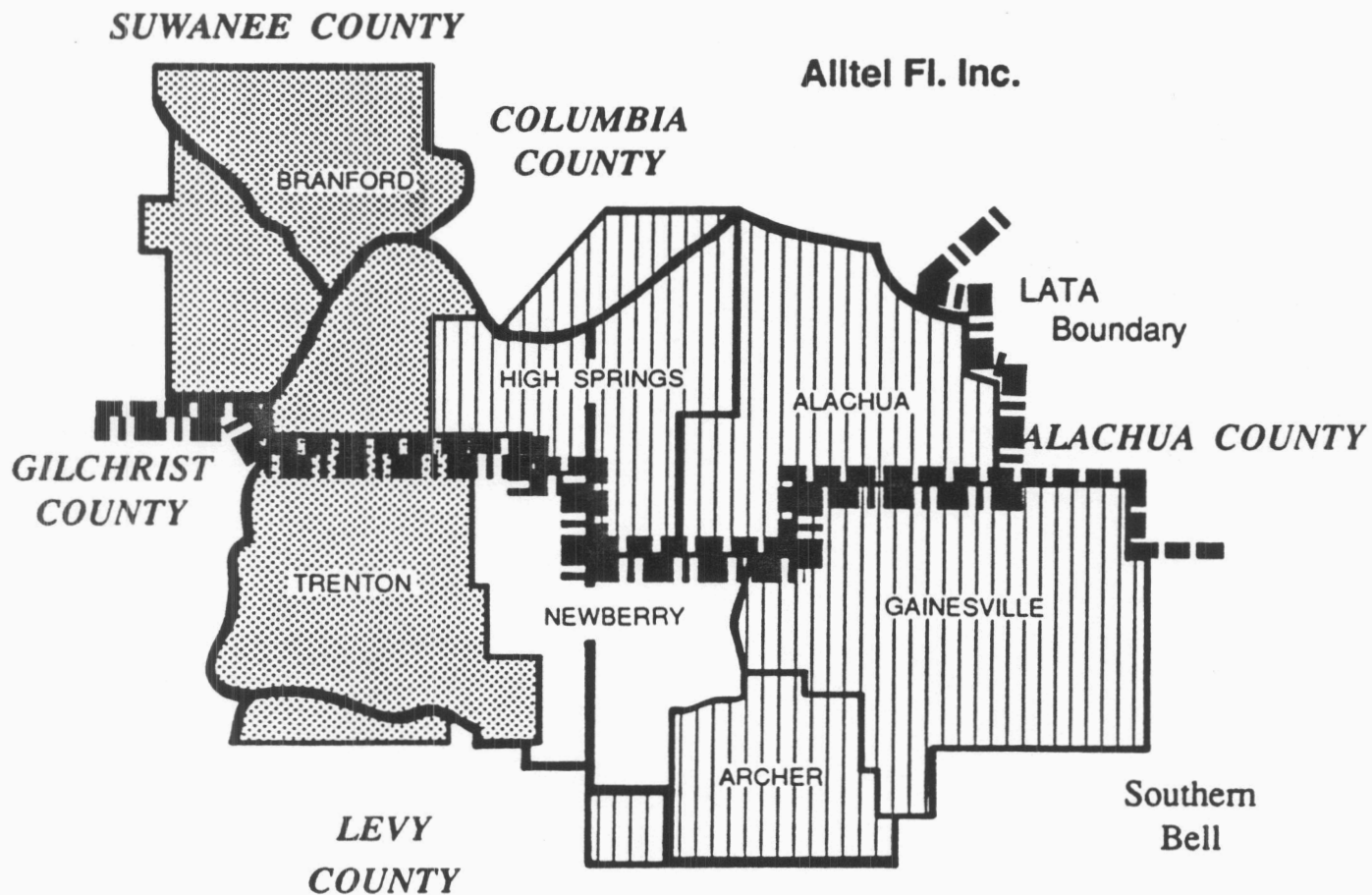

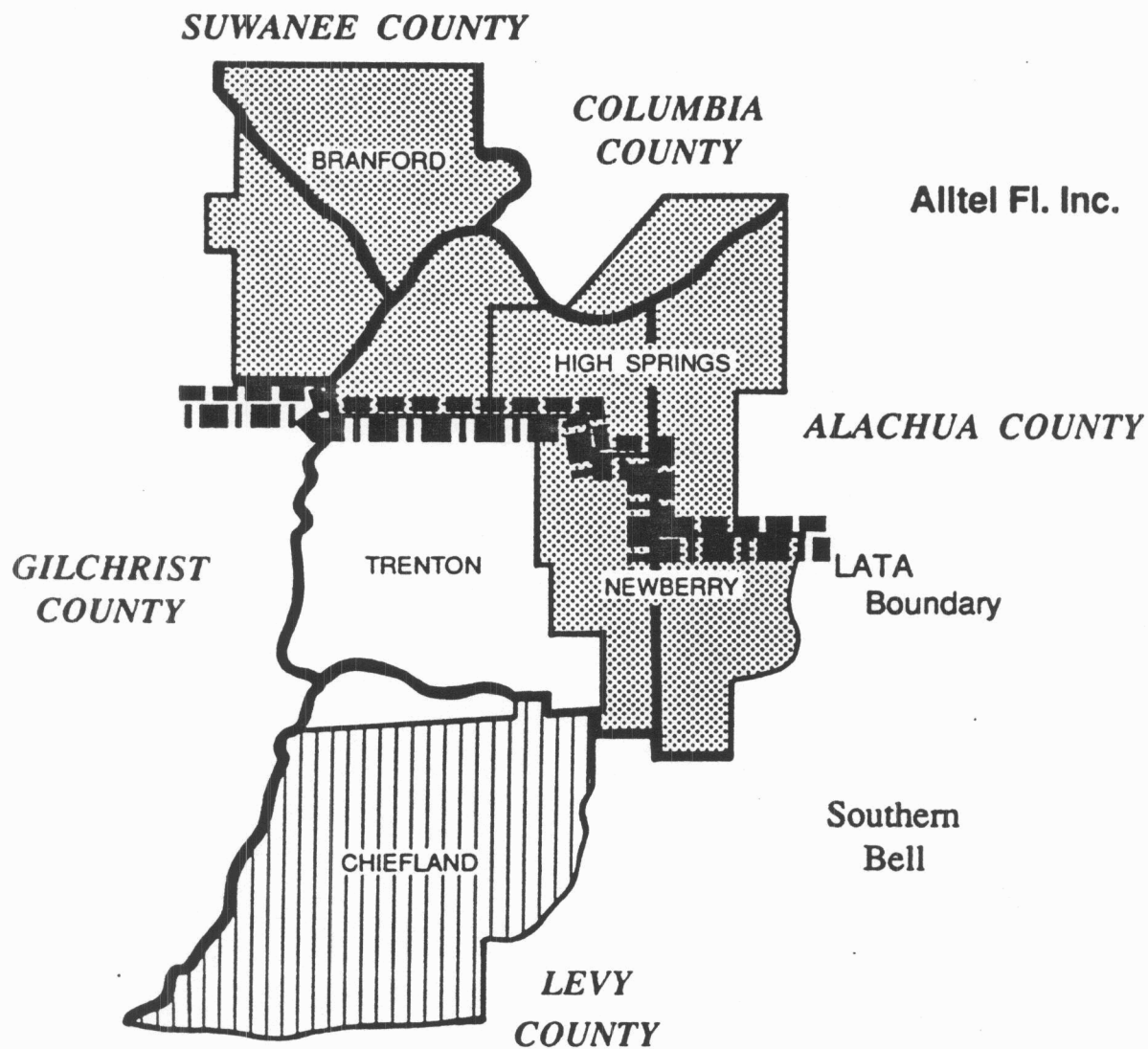


