



Dear Sir:

This organization represents a member coalition of civic organizations throughout west Pasco County, whose concern is to the ever increasing taxes that are being brought to bear on the voters throughout this state.

This year, has seen so many tax increases that our member delegates have expressed concern over any new service that will bite into the pockets of our retired and elderly whose income is derived from pensions and investments. With the downturn in the economy this calendar year, so many of our elderly are being hurt financially and that establishes the basis for this letter.

Recently, the Pasco County Commission has publicly made known their interest to the General Telephone Company for extending the telephone service from its present services along the rate corridor of West Pasco County, to an entire county-wide dialing service, which we understand would create a new base rate structure. The telephone company is to undertake a study at the behest of the Pasco County Commission, but should that study indicate the feasibility for extending the service area eastward, there is no doubt, that, for your consideration, rate adjustments will be presented to bear the cost through increases to each telephone subscriber.

The telephone subscriber here in West Pasco County has little interest in the amalgamation of telephone service throughout the entire county as the long distance telephone calls most frequently made are along the corridor of the Suncoast, which presently has its restrictions to rate areas from Port Richey and Hudson to the Holiday and north Pinellas areas and southward within the GTE service area. Thus, any unilateral action on the part of your commission to approve a new base rate to our West Pasco telephone subscribers for unwanted service would not be in the interest of our subscriber area.

While this letter may be premature, we ask that you place this request on record that we are opposed to any extension of the telephone service county-wide, should that service and a new rate be requested.





**Genesis of this docket:**

The Pasco County Board of Commissioners filed a resolution 4/19/91 requesting implementation of EAS between all Pasco County exchanges (Brooksville, Dade City, Hudson, New Port Richey, San Antonio, Tampa-North, Tampa-West, Tarpon Springs, Trillacoochee, and Zephyrhills). The Hernando County Board of Commissioners filed a resolution 2/10/92 requesting implementation of EAS between the Trillacoochee and Brooksville exchanges.

**Exchange information:**

*? Doesn't seem to be in Pasco County based on the map* *OK*  
GTEFL serves the Hudson, New Port Richey, Tampa, and Zephyrhills exchanges. Southern Bell serves the Brooksville exchange. United serves the Dade City, San Antonio, and Trillacoochee exchanges. The GTEFL exchanges are located in the Tampa Market Area. The Southern Bell and United exchanges are located in the Gainesville LATA. Attachment A is a map of the involved exchanges. Attachment B contains pertinent exchange data.

**Pertinent orders:**

Order No. 24718, issued 6/26/91, required the companies to conduct traffic studies. Order No. 24858, issued 7/29/91, granted GTEFL an extension of time to file the traffic studies. All three companies requested confidential treatment of the interLATA traffic data. Order No. 25267, issued 10/29/91, granted confidentiality.

**DISCUSSION OF ISSUES**

**ISSUE 1:** Do the calling rates on any of the toll routes considered in this docket qualify for a survey for nonoptional, flat rate, two-way toll free calling? (Refer to Table 1 for a list of routes)

**RECOMMENDATION:** Yes, the calling rates on the Trillacoochee-Brooksville route qualify for a survey for nonoptional, flat rate, two-way toll free calling. The Commission should order a survey of customers in the Trillacoochee exchange at the rates shown in issue 2, for the 25/25 plan with regrouping, which is a nonoptional, flat-rate, two-way EAS plan. The survey should begin within thirty (30) days of the final order in this docket. United Telephone should obtain staff's prior approval of the survey letter. The existing OEAS plan on the Brooksville/Trillacoochee should be discontinued at the time EAS is implemented, if the survey passes. None of the other toll routes considered in this docket qualify for a survey for nonoptional, flat rate, two-way toll free calling.

**Rule requirements:**

Rule 25-4.060(2), F.A.C. requires a two-way calling rate of two (2) M/M/Ms or greater with at least 50% of the exchange subscribers making two (2) or more calls per month. Alternatively, a one-way calling rate of three (3) M/M/Ms or greater with at least 50% of the exchange subscribers making one (1) or more calls per month is adequate if the petitioning exchange is less than half the size of the exchange to which EAS is sought.

**Calling volumes:**

The calling rates for all of the routes at issue in this docket are listed in the table above, except for those interLATA routes which have been granted confidential treatment. The calling rates for the interLATA routes which have been granted confidentiality have not been presented in this recommendation. The data, however, is available for review by the Commissioners. The one-way calling volumes on the Trillacoochee-Brooksville route qualify for a survey for nonoptional, flat rate, two-way toll free calling. None of the other routes qualify for a survey for nonoptional, flat rate, two way toll free calling.

**25/25 plan:**

In all recent EAS dockets in which calling volumes were sufficient to warrant consideration of non-optional, flat rate, toll free calling the Commission has approved surveys on the 25/25 plan with regrouping rather than regrouping alone. Under the 25/25 plan with regrouping subscribers are charged two additives to their standard monthly rates, as shown in issue 2.

**ISSUE 2:** At what rates should the non-optional, flat rate, two-way, toll free calling be implemented?

**How rates were calculated:**

The 25/25 additives shown above were derived by first calculating the additional calling scope for the Trillacoochee subscribers. The number of access lines by which the calling scope of the Trillacoochee exchanges will increase is simply the number of access lines in the Brooksville exchange (17,709). This number of access lines was then applied to United Telephone's rate group schedule. The additional calling scope would fall into rate group I and the 25/25 additives compute to be R-1 - \$1.62, B-1 - \$3.79, and PBX - \$7.57.

With the addition of 17,709 access lines to the current calling scope in the Trillacoochee (39,579) exchange, the new total would be 57,288, which would regroup from current rate group II to rate group III reflecting the following increases:

**STAFF ANALYSIS:**

**Routes with calling rates consistent with Countywide EAS:**

The one-way calling volumes on the Dade City/Brooksville, Dade City/Tampa-North, Hudson/Brooksville, Hudson/Tarpon Springs, San Antonio/Brooksville, San Antonio/Tampa-North, Tampa-North/New Port Richey, and Tampa-West/New Port Richey routes are consistent with the calling volumes seen in other countywide EAS requests.

**Routes which would be leapfrogged:**

No routes would be leapfrogged if some form of toll alternative were implemented on the routes listed above.

**Recommendation:**

Staff recommends that should any EAS alternative be implemented on any routes in this docket, such alternative be implemented on a two-way basis. Specifically, as outlined below, staff recommends that the \$.25 plan be implemented, in both directions, on the routes listed above.

**How does this recommendation differ from other Countywide EAS recommendation?**

The recommendation is consistent with staff's recommendation in several other countywide EAS dockets, to the extent that the \$.25 plan has been recommended on some routes with relatively low volume calling. This recommendation differs from other countywide EAS dockets, however, in that even if this recommendation is approved there will still be four exchanges in Pasco County which

do not have calling to the county seat, Dade City. A major county government services center is located in the New Port Richey exchange, the largest exchange in Pasco County. Thus, New Port Richey functions somewhat as a secondary seat of government in Pasco County. If this recommendation is approved all Pasco County residents could call either Dade City or New Port Richey. A draft rule for countywide calling came before the Commission at the February 4, agenda conference. The Commission decided to ~~workshop~~ <sup>extra</sup> the rule. The first workshop is scheduled for March 17, 1992. If that rule goes into effect the remaining intracounty routes would be served by the \$.25 plan.

#### Past policy:

In several recent dockets the Commission has ordered the \$.25 plan as an alternative to traditional EAS. Recent examples include Franklin, Gulf, Jackson, Holmes, Okaloosa, and Walton Counties where the plan was ordered on a countywide basis (with the rate subsequently reduced to \$.20 per call in all but Franklin and Gulf Counties). In Bradford County the \$.25 plan was ordered on nearly all the intracounty routes, as well as on several routes between Bradford County and Gainesville. The plan has also been ordered recently in the Central Florida area on the Reedy Creek/Kissimmee, Kissimmee/Orlando, St. Cloud/Orlando, West Kissimmee/Orlando, Mt. Dora/Orlando, Mt. Dora/Winter Park, Mt. Dora/Apopka, Sanford/Orange City, and Sanford/Deland routes.

#### Why the \$.25 plan?

The \$.25 plan has gained favor for several reasons. Among them are its simplicity, its message rate structure, and the fact that it can be implemented as a local calling plan on an interLATA basis. Optional EAS plans, particularly OEAS plans, are somewhat confusing to customers, the additives or buy-ins are generally rather high, and the take rates for most OEAS plans are rather low. The Commission has expressed concern that ~~when~~ Toll-PAC ~~is~~ <sup>will</sup> implemented, a three minute message will still have a substantial cost to the customer. For example, in the peak period a three minute message from Hudson to Tarpon Springs or from New Port Richey to Tampa-West would only be reduced from \$.60 to \$.42 (based on GTEFL rates). An additional argument in favor of the \$.25 plan for the interLATA routes is that the \$.25 plan (which converts the traffic to local status, and is implemented on a seven digit basis) is feasible for interLATA routes, whereas most other usage sensitive alternatives to EAS are feasible only for intraLATA routes.

#### Recap:

Staff recommends that the \$.25 plan be implemented on a two-way basis for the following routes:

The traffic studies reflect sufficient community of interest to warrant implementation of an alternative to toll rates, and the alternatives being recommended in this docket do not consider the costs in order to set the rates. The companies should be relieved of the cost studies required by Commission Rule 25-4.061, Determination of Costs.

**ISSUE 5:** Should the toll alternative plan require full recovery of costs and lost revenues, including incremental costs?

**RECOMMENDATION:** No, the toll alternative plan should not require full recovery of costs and lost revenues, including incremental costs. Rule 25-4.062(4) should be waived.

**STAFF ANALYSIS:**

**Rule requirements:**

In situations where the qualification for extended area service relies on the calling interest of the petitioning exchange as well as subscriber approval of the plan, recovery of costs is assigned as follows:

[T]he requested service may still be implemented, provided that the entire incremental cost for the new service, less any additional revenues generated by regrouping in either or both exchanges, shall be borne by the subscribers of the petitioning exchange (Rule 25-4.062(4), F.A.C.).

Therefore, on any two-way plan, according to the Rule, the subscribers in the petitioning exchange should bear the burden and the telephone company will recover the costs in whatever manner the Commission deems.

**Past policy:**

In virtually every EAS docket (e.g. Docket No. 870436-TL, Hastings-St. Augustine EAS) for which cost information has been submitted, it has been shown that full recovery of cost would result in unacceptably high rates to customers. For this reason, the Commission has waived this rule in every EAS docket for which traditional EAS has been recommended. Although this recommendation is for an alternative to traditional EAS the same rationale applies.

**ISSUE 6:** Should the revenue impact and associated costs of this recommendation on Southern Bell be recognized in Docket No. 880069-TL, and should stimulation be taken into account?

**RECOMMENDATION:** Yes. Any revenue impact on Southern Bell should be calculated after the plan has been implemented for six months, so as to account for stimulation. The revenue impact should be applied to the EAS set aside in Docket No. 880069-TL.

**STAFF ANALYSIS:**

**EAS set-aside:**

In Docket No. 880069-TL an annual sum of \$10 million was set aside for EAS. Southern Bell has been allowed to offset, against the \$10 million pool, the revenue impact of EAS plans implemented since the monies were set aside. In Docket No. 910528-TL, Putnam

County EAS and Docket No. 910763-TL, St. John's County EAS the Commission voted to allow additional costs, other than lost revenue, to be considered when stimulation is taken into account.

**Stimulation:**

It has become clear that in instances where the \$.25 plan has been implemented there has been significant stimulation. Staff believes it appropriate to recognize this stimulation in determining the actual revenue impact to Southern Bell. Data for the \$.25 plans implemented in Centel's territory has shown that the bulk of stimulation takes place in the first several months after implementation. Staff believes that six months is an appropriate length of time after which to consider stimulation for this purpose.

**ISSUE 7:** What is the appropriate treatment of directory listings when seven digit dialed \$.25 plans are implemented?

**RECOMMENDATION:** Since seven digit dialed \$.25 calls are considered local calls, directory listings should be provided to all affected customers when new directories are published. However, implementation of the \$.25 plan on the ordered routes should not be delayed until new directories are published, nor should a special directory be required.

**STAFF ANALYSIS:**

**Rule requirements:**

"When expanded calling scopes are involved, as with Extended Area Service, each subscriber shall be provided with directory listings for all published telephone numbers within the local service area." (Rule 25-4.040(2), F.A.C.)

This rule has generally been interpreted to mean that new, expanded, directory listings be furnished to customers at the time when EAS is implemented.

**Rationale:**

Unlike traditional EAS, the \$.25 plan can generally be implemented rather quickly, since new facilities are rarely necessary. There has been some question, however, as to whether the involved companies had to provide the additional directory listings at the time the \$.25 plan was implemented. Rather than publishing special interim directories, or distributing copies of

existing directories, both of which can be expensive, the companies have suggested waiting until the regularly scheduled publishing date for new directories. In one instance this would extend the potential implementation date for an additional six months.

Staff believes that the \$.25 plan should be implemented as quickly as possible when ordered. Staff also believes that it is reasonable to wait until the regularly scheduled publishing date to produce and distribute new directories, rather than subjecting the involved companies, and subsequently the ratepayers, to additional directory expense. Unlike traditional EAS, in instances where the \$.25 plan is ordered, basic local rates do not increase. When basic local rates increase because of EAS, it is reasonable that ratepayers have immediate access to listings for their additional calling scope. This is because they are paying for exactly that, the additional calling scope. With the \$.25 plan no subscriber faces a rate increase, they face only a reduction in the price of their calls.

ISSUE 8: Should Docket No. 910529-TL be closed?

RECOMMENDATION: No. This docket should remain open until United Telephone has surveyed the Trillacoochee customers, the survey results have been reported to the Commission, and GTEFL and Southern Bell have secured the necessary waiver of the MFJ to carry traffic on the interLATA routes, after which the docket should be closed administratively.


STAFF ANALYSIS:

**Rationale:**

The Commission has ordered implementation of the \$.25 plan on several interLATA routes in several other dockets. In each instance Southern Bell has been required to seek a waiver of the MFJ. In each instance Southern Bell has subsequently submitted a motion for extension of time because the Department of Justice has yet to make a recommendation on any of the pending waiver requests. Rather than closing this docket, only to reopen it several months later, staff recommends this docket be kept open until such time as the waiver is granted.



MOTION OF THE UNITED STATES  
TO HOLD GTE'S MOTION IN ABEYANCE

On May 12, 1992, GTE Corporation filed a motion for an order authorizing GTE Florida Incorporated to provide interLATA non-optional, message-rate extended area service ("EAS") among its Hudson and Tampa-North exchanges, which are part of the unaffiliated Tampa Market Area, and the Brooksville, Dade City, and San Antonio exchanges (served by Southern Bell and United Telephone), which are located in the Gainesville LATA. The Department understands that BellSouth will shortly be requesting a similar waiver of the AT&T consent decree that will involve the same set of exchanges, as well as the same types of decree issues and competitive considerations. Therefore, the Department moves for an order holding GTE's motion in abeyance so that the GTE and BellSouth requests can be considered simultaneously. GTE has authorized the Department to represent that it does not oppose this request.

As described in GTE's motion, the Florida Public Service Commission ("Florida PSC") has ordered GTE Florida, Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company, and United Telephone Company of Florida to provide non-optional, message-rate extended area service ("EAS") among the Brooksville, Dade City, Hudson, New Port Richey, San Antonio, Tampa-North, Tampa-West, and Tarpon Springs exchanges,


each of which is located either totally or partially within Pasco County, Florida. Recognizing the interLATA nature of a number of these arrangements, the Florida PSC ordered GTE Florida and Southern Bell to seek waivers of the GTE consent decree and the Modified Final Judgment, respectively, to permit them to provide the interLATA services required by its order. Accordingly, on May 12, 1992, GTE filed its motion for such authority.

The proposed EAS arrangements involve an unusually high number of access lines: the five exchanges involved in the EAS arrangements in which GTE Florida will be participating currently have over 85,000 access lines. Thus, while GTE's motion does not state the volume of interexchange traffic that will be affected by the proposed EAS, the volume of interexchange traffic affected is potentially much greater than typically involved in waiver requests for EAS. Moreover, the proposed arrangements involve an alternative to traditional EAS service. The Florida PSC's order states that "[i]n cases where calling rates and community of interest considerations were not sufficient to justify traditional EAS, [the PSC has] considered various optional toll discount plans." *Florida PSC Order* at 7 (Exhibit A to GTE's motion). The proposed EAS is non-optional but implements a \$0.25 per call charge for these EAS calls. The Department is currently reviewing other waiver requests that involve similar forms of EAS arrangements in the state of Florida.

BellSouth has not yet filed its waiver request to provide the EAS arrangements mandated in the same Florida PSC order. Its request will involve the same set of exchanges and will present the same types of decree issues and competitive considerations. Thus, in light of these similarities and the unusual character of the proposed EAS arrangements, the Department believes that the GTE waiver request should be reviewed in conjunction with the forthcoming BellSouth waiver request. Accordingly, the Department requests that the Court enter the attached proposed order holding GTE's motion in abeyance. As provided in the proposed order, the

Department will file its substantive response to GTE's motion within five days of its filing on the corresponding BellSouth waiver request so that the Court can consider the two requests simultaneously.





REQUEST OF BELL SOUTH CORPORATION FOR A WAIVER  
OF THE MODIFICATION OF FINAL JUDGMENT TO IMPLEMENT  
A TWO-WAY, \$.25 PER MESSAGE EXTENDED AREA SERVICE  
( "EAS" ) PLAN BETWEEN THE BROOKSVILLE AND HUDSON,  
EXCHANGES IN PASCO AND HERNANDO COUNTIES, FLORIDA

Pursuant to an order of the Florida Public Service Commission, BellSouth Corporation, on behalf of BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company ("Southern Bell" or "Company"), submits the following request for a waiver of the Decree to the Department of Justice for presentation to the Court.

Southern Bell seeks a waiver to provide a two-way, \$.25 Per Message Extended Area Service ("EAS") Plan between the Brooksville, Florida and Hudson, Florida exchanges. The Brooksville exchange is served by Southern Bell and is in Hernando and Pasco Counties. The Hudson exchange is served by General Telephone Company of Florida ("General") and is in Pasco County.<sup>1</sup> The Brooksville

exchange is in the Gainesville LATA and the Hudson exchange is in the unaffiliated Tampa market area.

The Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") has issued a notice of proposed agency action implementing several two-way \$.25 Per Message Plans (the "Plan") in Hernando and Pasco Counties. However, the only portion of the plan for which Southern Bell requires a waiver of the Decree is for the Brooksville to Hudson EAS route.<sup>2</sup> The Commission specifically found that this Plan is favorable because of its simplicity, its message rate structure, and the fact that it can be implemented as a local calling plan, with seven-digit dialing, on an interLATA basis.<sup>3</sup>

The Commission further ordered that Southern Bell and General immediately seek a waiver of the Decree to carry the traffic on the interLATA route and that the Plan be implemented within six months of April 28, 1992, the date on which the proposed agency action became final.

For the foregoing reasons, BellSouth requests that the Department of Justice concur in this request and move for an Order of the Court permitting Southern Bell to implement the two-way,



NOTICE OF PROPOSED AGENCY ACTION  
ORDER REQUIRING SURVEY OF CUSTOMERS  
FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF EXTENDED AREA  
SERVICE AND REQUIRING IMPLEMENTATION  
OF ALTERNATIVE TOLL PLAN

BY THE COMMISSION:

NOTICE is hereby given by the Florida Public Service Commission that the action discussed herein is preliminary in nature and will become final unless a person whose interests are adversely affected files a petition for a formal proceeding, pursuant to Rule 25-22.029, Florida Administrative Code.

BACKGROUND

This docket was initiated pursuant to Resolution No. 91-217 filed with this Commission by the Pasco County Board of County Commissioners. The Resolution requested that we consider requiring implementation of extended area serviced (EAS) between all exchanges located in Pasco County. Pasco County contains the following exchanges or portions of exchanges: Brooksville, Dade City, Hudson, New Port Richey, San Antonio, Tampa-North, Tampa-West, Tarpon Springs, Trillacoochee, and Zephyrhills.

Subsequently, the Hernando County Board of County Commissioners filed a resolution requesting that we consider requiring implementation of EAS between the Trillacoochee and Brooksville exchanges. Although these two exchanges are located primarily in Hernando County, each exchange also has a pocket area located in Pasco County. For that reason, we determined it was appropriate to consider the Hernando County resolution in this docket.

By Order No. 24718, issued June 26, 1991, we directed GTE Florida Incorporated (GTEFL), Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company (Southern Bell), and United Telephone Company of Florida (United) to perform traffic studies between these exchanges to determine whether a sufficient community of interest exists, pursuant to Rule 25-4.060, Florida Administrative Code. All of the exchanges involved in these EAS requested are served by GTEFL, except the Dade City, San Antonio, and Trillacoochee exchanges, which are served by United, and the Brooksville exchange, which is served by Southern Bell.

In addition to involving intercompany routes, these requests also involve interLATA (local access transport area) routes. The GTEFL exchanges are located in the Tampa Market Area (LATA), while the Southern Bell and United exchanges are located in the Gainesville LATA. The companies were directed to prepare and submit the traffic studies to us within sixty (60) days of the issuance date of Order No. 24718, making the studies due by August 26, 1991.

On July 17, 1991, GTEFL filed a Motion for Extension of Time requesting an extension through and including September 26, 1991, in which to prepare and submit the required traffic studies. By Order No. 24858, issued July 29, 1991, we granted GTEFL's request.

Subsequently, all three companies filed the requested traffic study data, along with Requests for Specified Confidential Classification of certain portions of the traffic study data. Southern Bell made its filing on August 26, 1991; United on September 17, 1991; and GTEFL on September 26, 1991. Each of the companies requested specified confidential treatment of only that data which represented a quantification of traffic along interLATA routes. By Order No. 25267, issued October 29, 1991, we granted these three requests.

Each of the involved exchanges currently has EAS as follows:

Rates for the Brooksville exchange would not increase; therefore, the Brooksville subscribers are not included in the survey. Rates for the 25/25 plan with regrouping are derived by developing two additives. The 25/25 additive is twenty-five percent (25%) of the rate group schedule for the number of access lines to be added to the exchange's calling scope. The regrouping additive is the difference in rates between the exchange's original rate group and the new rate group into which the exchange will fall with its expanded calling scope.

The subscribers in the Trillacoochee exchange shall be surveyed by United within thirty (30) days of the date this Order becomes final. Prior to conducting the survey, United shall submit its explanatory survey letter and ballot to our staff for approval.

If the survey passes by a simple majority of the customers in the Trillacoochee exchange, United and Southern Bell shall then implement toll free calling between Trillacoochee and Brooksville within twelve (12) months of the issuance date of our order on survey approval. The existing OEAS plan on the Brooksville to Trillacoochee route shall be discontinued at the time EAS is implemented. By our requiring a simple majority, we are hereby waiving the fifty-one percent (51%) favorable vote requirement of Rule 25-4.063(5)(a), Florida Administrative Code.

In addition, we find it appropriate to require GTEFL, Southern Bell, and United to implement the alternative toll plan known as the \$.25 plan on the following routes (between these exchanges): Dade City to Brooksville; Dade City to Tampa-North; Hudson to Brooksville; Hudson to Tarpon Springs\*; San Antonio to Brooksville; San Antonio to Tampa-North; Tampa-North to New Port Richey\*; and Tampa-West to New Port Richey\*. Calls between these exchanges shall be rated at \$.25 per call, regardless of call duration. These calls shall be furnished on a seven-digit basis where technically feasible and shall be reclassified as local for all purposes. These calls shall be handled by pay telephone providers in the same way and at the same price to end users as any other local call. Pay telephone providers shall be charged the standard local measured usage rate for these calls. Customers may make an unlimited number of calls at \$.25 per call. For those three routes above that are intraLATA routes and served solely by GTEFL (marked by \*), the Extended Calling Service (ECS) rates approved in Docket No. 910179-TL shall apply in lieu of the standard \$.25 plan rates. ECS rates for residential customers are the same as the standard \$.25 plan; that is, a \$.25 per call charge applies. However, for

business customers, ECS rates are measured. Currently, ECS business rates are \$.10 for the first minute and \$.06 for each additional minute.

Because calls under the \$.25 plan are considered local for all purposes, affected customers shall be provided with appropriate directory listings. However, implementation of the \$.25 plan shall not be delayed nor shall special directories be required. Rather, these listing shall be furnished to affected customers at the next regularly scheduled directory publishing and distribution date. We believe this interpretation of Rule 25-4.040(2), Florida Administrative Code, is reasonable, particularly since basic local rates do not increase under the \$.25 plan as they do with traditional flat rate EAS.

The companies shall implement the \$.25 plan within six (6) months of the date this Order becomes final. However, for those routes where GTEFL provides service to at least one exchange, the plan shall be implemented by January 1, 1993. Southern Bell shall immediately begin seeking a waiver of the Modified Final Judgment, and GTEFL shall immediately begin seeking a waiver of the Consent Decree, to allow them to carry traffic on the affected routes. Terminating access charges shall not be paid or collected on routes where the \$.25 plan is implemented, since such routes are considered local. The companies shall file appropriate tracking reports with our staff following implementation of the \$.25 plan.

In reaching the decision to require the \$.25 plan, we considered those routes with calling volumes that were higher than average, but below the threshold of the Rule. We note that there are no routes that would be "leapfrogged" by our proposal. The calling rates on the remaining routes in this docket are relatively small. Even with this proposed calling plan, there will be four exchanges in Pasco County that do not have calling to the county seat, Dade City. However, a major county governmental services center is located in the New Port Richey exchange; thus, New Port Richey functions somewhat as a secondary seat of government for Pasco County. With our proposed calling plan, all Pasco County residents will be able to call either Dade City or New Port Richey.

In cases where calling rates and community of interest considerations were not sufficient to justify traditional EAS, we have considered various optional toll discount plans. The specific plan offered is generally dependent upon the traffic volumes on the routes under consideration. In cases where traffic volumes are

extremely low, or where community of interest factors are insufficient, we have sometimes rejected any toll alternative whatsoever.

The \$.25 plan has gained favor for several reasons. Among these are its simplicity, its message rate structure, and the fact that it can be implemented as a local calling plan on an interLATA basis. Optional EAS plans, particularly OEAS plans, are somewhat confusing to customers, the additives or buy-ins are generally rather high, and the take rates for most OEAS plans are rather low. We have also expressed our concern that when Toll-PAC is implemented, a three minute message will still have a substantial cost to the customer. For example, in the peak period, a three minute message from Hudson to Tarpon Springs, or from New Port Richey to Tampa-West, would only be reduced from \$.60 to \$.42 (based on GTEFL rates). However, a more important reason in this particular instance is that the \$.25 plan (which converts the traffic to local status, and is implemented on a seven-digit basis) is feasible for interLATA routes, whereas most other usage sensitive alternatives to EAS are feasible only for intraLATA routes.

For both the flat rate EAS and the \$.25 plan that we have proposed, we find it appropriate to waive Rule 25-4.061, Florida Administrative Code. Because the traffic studies reflect a sufficient community of interest and the toll relief plans being authorized do not consider costs to set rates, we do not believe it is necessary to require the companies to conduct cost studies on these routes.

We also find it appropriate to waive the requirements of Rule 25-4.062(4), Florida Administrative Code, which provides for full recovery of costs from the subscribers in the petitioning exchange upon implementation of traditional, two-way, nonoptional EAS. Our experience with cost information that has been submitted to date in other EAS dockets has shown that to permit full recovery of costs would require us to approve rates that would be unacceptable to customers. Surveying customers on such high rates would ensure failure of the survey. Based on the high community of interest exhibited along the Brooksville to Trillacoochee route, we believe EAS is warranted and that a survey with more reasonable rates should be conducted. Additionally, we have not required cost recovery in any docket for which traditional EAS has been ordered since the effective date of this rule. Therefore, we intend to waive Rule 25-4.062(4) for this route.

We also find it appropriate to waive Rule 25-4.062(4) to the extent that this rule arguably applies to the \$.25 plan routes. We recognize that there is an economic impact to the companies as a result of our proposed \$.25 plan. However, if the \$.25 plan is compared with traditional EAS, it is clear that the impact of the \$.25 plan is not as great as flat rate EAS. In fact, the \$.25 plan offers the opportunity for additional revenue if there is sufficient stimulation. Although stimulation levels can be difficult, even impossible to predict, initial reports concerning the \$.25 plan in other areas of the state show that the number of calls can increase dramatically. While the demographics of these areas may differ, we do believe that some stimulation is inevitable. We shall take stimulation into account to determine the actual revenue impact to Southern Bell when applying this lost revenue to the EAS monies set aside in Docket No. 880069-TL. In so doing, we find it appropriate to also recognize additional associated costs, other than lost revenue, and to take those costs into account. Finally, because we believe that the bulk of stimulation occurs within the first few months following implementation, we find six months to be an appropriate length of time after which to consider stimulation for this purpose.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that the resolutions filed with this Commission by the Pasco County Board of County Commissioners and the Hernando County Board of County Commissioners are hereby approved to the extent outlined herein. It is further

ORDERED that if no proper protest is filed within the time frame set forth below, United Telephone Company of Florida shall, within thirty (30) days of the date this Order becomes final, survey its subscribers in the Trillacoochee exchange for implementation of a flat rate, two-way, nonoptional extended area service plan that complies with the terms and conditions set forth herein. It is further

ORDERED that if the survey passes, the flat rate, two-way, nonoptional extended area service plan described herein shall be implemented on the Trillacoochee to Brooksville route by United Telephone Company of Florida and Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company within twelve months of the issuance date of our order on survey approval. It is further

NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.59(4), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that is available under Sections 120.57 or 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

The action proposed herein is preliminary in nature and will not become effective or final, except as provided by Rule 25-22.029, Florida Administrative Code. Any person whose substantial interests are affected by the action proposed by this order may file a petition for a formal proceeding, as provided by Rule 25-22.029(4), Florida Administrative Code, in the form provided by Rule 25-22.036(7)(a) and (f), Florida Administrative Code. This petition must be received by the Director, Division of Records and Reporting at his office at 101 East Gaines Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0870, by the close of business on APRIL 27, 1992

In the absence of such a petition, this order shall become effective on the day subsequent to the above date as provided by Rule 25-22.029(6), Florida Administrative Code.

Any objection or protest filed in this docket before the issuance date of this order is considered abandoned unless it satisfies the foregoing conditions and is renewed within the specified protest period.

If this order becomes final and effective on the date described above, any party adversely affected may request judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility or by the First District Court of Appeal in the case of a water or wastewater utility by filing a notice of appeal with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting and filing a copy of the notice of appeal and the filing fee with the appropriate court. This filing must be completed within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this order, pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure. The notice of appeal must be in the form specified in Rule 9.900(a), Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.


