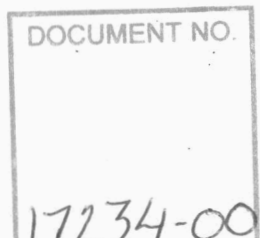



Thank you for your letter dated December 6, 1995, regarding calling within Volusia County. Your concerns are being addressed in several dockets currently pending before the Commission.

With respect to your concern about calling into north Volusia County (Orange City/Daytona Beach, Orange City/New Smyrna Beach, Orange City/Oak Hill, and Orange City/Pierson routes), these interLATA routes were considered at the Commission's December 5, 1995, Agenda Conference. At that time, the Commission decided to defer action on these routes because of concerns expressed by the companies involved in billing and implementing the interLATA plan proposed by the Commission's staff. The Commission directed staff and the parties to resolve these issues. A workshop was held on January 23, 1996. The Commission is scheduled to review the results of the workshop at its February 20, 1996, Agenda Conference.

The Commission also received a request on January 5, 1996, from Volusia County to consider extended area service (EAS) from the Orange City exchange to the Winter Park and Orlando exchanges (Altamonte Springs is served from the Orlando exchange). This request will address your concerns about having to pay long distance charges to call Altamonte Springs.


Volusia County's request will be affected by the new telecommunications law passed by the Florida legislature which became effective July 1, 1995. The new law removes the Commission's authority in EAS matters which involve local exchange companies that elect price regulation under the new law. Based on the new law, the Commission will not have the legislative authority to require Sprint United or BellSouth to process the EAS study as requested by Volusia County since both local exchange companies elected price regulation. Any further action on Volusia County's request will be at the option of Sprint United and BellSouth.

I would also like to address your concern that EAS should be based on distance or geographic location. EAS routes in place today were implemented based upon an exhibited need, rather than distance, geographic location or customer desire. In the past, the Commission allowed EAS where there was a "community of interest." Prior to the passage of the telecommunications law, a community of interest was found to exist where the calling volume had an average calling rate of at least three messages per month per access line, and at least 50% of those subscribers made two or more calls per month to the other exchange. The Commission's past policy for an alternative toll plan, such as the \$.25 plan, required an average calling rate of at least three calls per month per access line, and 40% of the subscribers must have made at least two calls per month.

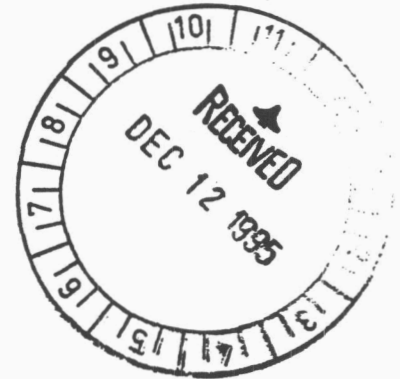

Dear Ms. Clark;

I read with dismay a story headlined "State puts quarter calls on hold - again," which appeared in today's Orlando Sentinel's Section D. It states that the "PSC, meeting Tuesday in Tallahassee, put off a request from the Volusia County Council that would have allowed residents to vote on local-calling preferences."

Residents would approve any plan that offered relief from exorbitant telephone rates that plague residents in this West Volusia County area. We have literally been caught in a geographical crack between 904 and 407 area codes, LATA and a federally created boundary meant to ensure competition among long-distance carriers. All this to the detriment of the consumer.

Let me plead my personal case of over \$100 phone bills just for the simple day-to-day life. It is not simple, it is very complicated. It is a 25-cent call for me to call my daughter within Deltona City boundaries some 7 miles away. I am in the 904 area represented by Sprint/United while Claudia is in a 407-323 Sanford exchange (even though she lives in Deltona) represented by BellSouth. I logged 15 calls to Claudia for the November bill for \$3.75. And I tried to keep it down! But calls to Daytona Beach, a mere 20 miles away, are regular long-distance rates as are Longwood and Altamonte Springs, also about 20 miles away. Those calls have ranged up to \$9.50 to talk to a business associate for 46 mins. during day rates. It would be cheaper to drive down I-4 22 miles to talk to her.

I am a computer graphic designer and fine artist with a home studio and as a new resident this awful phone setup has put a real dollar damper on my professional career. Calls for bookstores, computer supply stores and general business activities are beyond my financial capacity. It almost amounts to being unconstitutional to deprive a community local access calling rights. And I am not exaggerating or being a cry baby. I am a native Floridian used to geographical rates meaning logically 40-50 miles may be long-distance but 20 miles? Seven miles? As I read my phone book, I have access to only 13 calling exchanges in Deland, DeLeon Springs, DeBary, Lake Helen, Deltona and Deltona Lakes, all within 7-8 miles, none of which are metropolitan areas.

Deltona, which recently voted to incorporate into a city with at least 55,000 residents, is considered a bedroom community for business commuters to Orlando, DisneyWorld, Titusville's Space Center and Daytona.

Check my facts, look at your maps, come down and talk to Deltona and West Volusia officials. And please help me and Deltona residents get relief from unnecessary long distance bills and greedy companies. You are represented to be for the public to give us poor people help. I would greatly appreciate your help in this matter. Thank you in advance.

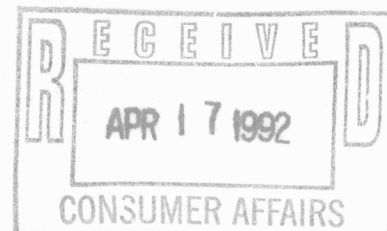

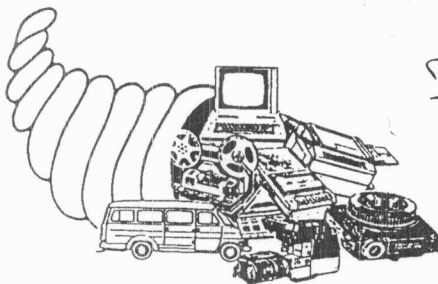

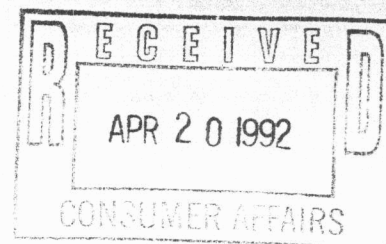

The Chairman is unable to respond to you because the matters raised in your letter are pending in Docket Nos. 910029-TL and 911185-TL. Section 350.042, Florida Statutes, prohibits Commissioners from receiving or initiating communications off the record involving open dockets. I will, however, place your letter on the record of the proceedings where they will be available for review by the parties to the proceedings.

As you stated, you have several interLATA routes in your County pending some form of interLATA toll relief. I write this letter to personally express to you and your fellow commissioners how very important it is that the extended area service (EAS) docket issues, 910029-TL and 911185-TL, be brought to a successful closure with some plan resembling the proposals now under consideration involving the smallest possible flat rate buy-in and \$.25 calling. I specifically represent the Southwest Volusia County area including the new city of Deltona as well as being the Vice-Chairman of the County Council. This makes me uniquely aware of the problems which have been existing within this portion of the County and especially between this area and the rest of Volusia County because of the local access transport area (LATA) boundary separating us. The problem is clearly seen in the new city of Deltona which is served by three (3) different exchanges, two different telephone companies and yet Volusia County government and the bulk of the business is on other exchanges and in another LATA.

Two issues are critical to the County concerning this matter. First, some version of the \$.25 plan needs to be implemented across the LATA between the Daytona Beach LATA exchanges and the Volusia County citizens in the Orlando LATA (DeBary and Orange City exchanges and a small pocket served by the Sanford exchange).

This would involve some of the people in Deltona, all of Osteen, Stone Island, Enterprise, etc. All those who have E911 service into Volusia County and get their telephone service from Sanford should be those balloted.



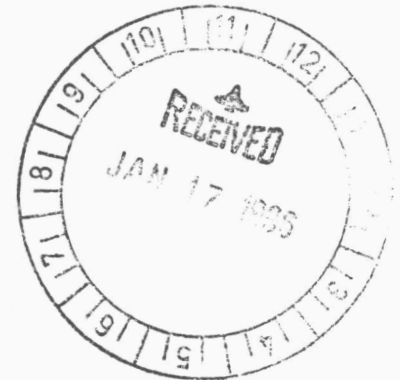

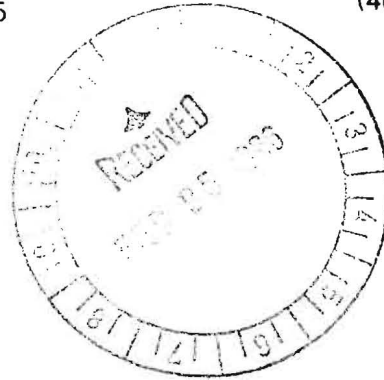

You express concern that you can call two counties south but can only call a small portion of Volusia County. The Commission ordered a countywide \$.25 plan within Volusia County in Docket No. 911185-TL. However, because federal law in effect at that time prohibited BellSouth from carrying calls from one LATA (local access transport area) to another (interLATA), there were several routes which could not be implemented.

Since the Commission's decision in this docket, the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 became effective. It is possible that this Act may alter the interLATA prohibitions for BellSouth. It is also possible that the new law may remove the balloting requirement. The Commission's staff is reviewing the Act to determine the impact on pending interLATA routes.

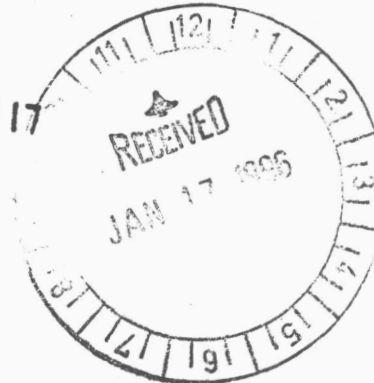

The Commission ordered a countywide \$.25 plan within Volusia County in Docket No. 911185-TL. 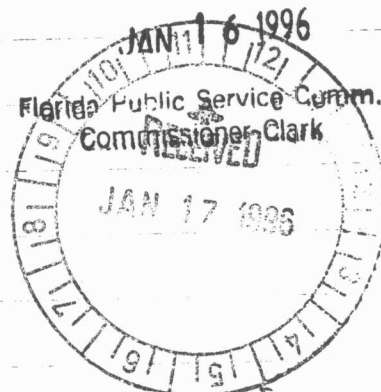

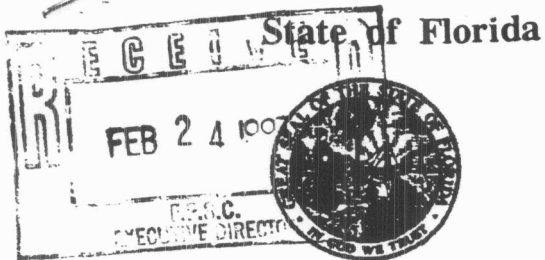



We are a SMALL group of Sprint-United Phone customers with a BIG problem. We are seeking relief from Sprint by signing the enclosed petition for application for extended calling service to the New Smyrna Beach and Daytona-Ormond calling area.

We have a New Smyrna Beach address, our children attend schools in New Smyrna Beach, most of us work in the Daytona-Ormond, New Smyrna Beach Area. Go to shop, doctors, hospitals etc. carry on our daily lives in the New Smyrna, Daytona-Ormond area but yet have an Orange City/Lake Helen phone exchange. This is a hardship for us because all of our calls are costly long distance to our local area. The average monthly phone bill for a family living in our area is \$100.00 a big chunk out of the budget.

Our address is New Smyrna Beach but yet if someone is to call information and ask for a listing in New Smyrna we do not exist. We are listed under Orange City. We had missed numerous calls because of this.

We are seeking relief with this petition because all of the traditional methods of relief have been exhausted. A few years back we called the Public Service Commission in Tallahassee and they referred us to start with our County government. We have spoken with our councilwomen Pat Northly. We have been to the Volusia County Council, I have spoke with Robert Weiss communications director for Volusia County, as a matter of fact when I spoke to him a few years back he was seeing about including us in the Lake Ashby switch. This never happened. It seems that because we are such a small group we are always forgotten or lost in the shuffle or system.

On July 17, 1996 I read an article on the Orlando Sentinel titled "25 Cent Call Link for Orange City to Move Forward" this caught my eye and I guess you could call it wisefol thinking but I thought our problem was solved. I called Brian Craven at Sprint only to be told "this did not

include our phone exchange. He was very understanding and sympathetic of the problem we have. He referred us to you.

Please understand that even our school age children suffer from this problem. For them to call their friends or friend to call them all communication is LONG DISTANCE. In the long run their social development is very limited as well as their phone calls. I have a 16 year old daughter so I'm sure you understand my problem.



Dear Mr. & Mrs. Wagner:

I received your letter and accompanying petition of July 25 requesting extended area service to locations east of your residences and am sincerely sympathetic to it. From your letter I think you are aware of the numerous actions the County government has taken in regard to calling rates and boundaries, working through the process of regulation and having probably more success than others in the state. I realize none of this has helped you yet but it seems like prospects are better for the future.

First, we have had an action at the Florida Public Service Commission since 1991 to give Sprint-United customers served out of Orange City \$.25 per call residential calling to all the other exchange areas in the county including all those you are requesting. Previous to this year the request was stalled in Washington, D.C. pending a waiver from a judge who had control over traffic crossing calling area boundaries. This is even though the Florida Public Service Commission (PSC) had approved our request and was actively trying to get it for us.

All rules changed however in February of this year due to the passage of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 as federal law. The issue was revisited by the PSC at a public agenda in March in Tallahassee. At that time the decision of the PSC was reaffirmed and the PSC staff was directed to pursue this again under the new legislation with the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) who now adjudicates or makes rules in such cases. We are now hopeful that this will move soon and provide you and me (I live in the United area also) with long distance relief.

Secondly, we are working with BellSouth and United to bring about \$.25 calling to Winter Park and Orlando. We have received correspondence recently from both companies indicating that they are hopeful of implementing this by the end of the year.



I am happy to advise you that the Florida Public Service Commission moved at the March 19, 1996 agenda, on Docket Number 91185-T1, that the above route be implemented. In addition to that, you will have Orange City to Daytona Beach, Oak Hill, Pierson, and Del.eon Springs.

BellSouth has to get approval from the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) to carry interLATA traffic; therefore, it will take some time for these routes to be implemented. As soon as we are notified and file our tariff you will receive notice in your telephone bill and you may also keep watch in the local newspaper for notification.

## Phone regulators: No easy answers in Volusia

DELTONA — The telephone tangle in southwest Volusia County could become even more snarled this summer.

The Florida Public Service Commission soon will consider two proposals that could have a big effect on residents in Deltona, DeBary, Lake Helen and Orange City. Already the area falls into two area codes and is served by two telephone companies, BellSouth and Sprint.

The new suggestions could add a third area code in Deltona — now split between 904 and 407 — and further complicate phone bills for residents.

Citing the explosion in the number of fax machines, portable phones and pagers, regulators have said the combinations of numbers within the 407 area code could be used up by year's end.

The commission could decide to use an area code "overlay," which means any new customers would get a new area code no matter where they are. If so, Deltona residents would have a third area code to decipher. That would mean everyone would begin dialing 10 digits to make even a local call.

If regulators choose the overlay idea, it would affect new numbers in Orange, Seminole and Osceola

"I really feel for them because I know that area has been frustrating for some consumers," PSC spokesman Robby Cunningham said. "But it's not going to get better. As far as area codes go, people need to look at the facts and know that things are changing, that dialing 10 digits is going to become commonplace."

The PSC will hold public hearings Aug. 6 in Melbourne and Aug. 7 in Orlando. It likely will make a decision later this year, Cunningham said.

The first overlay in the state, in Miami-Dade County, will become permanent July 1.

Instead of the overlay, the commission could simply split the 407 region and assign the new area code to one section.

The PSC also is considering a separate proposal to link about 28,000 Sprint customers in Deltona, Lake Helen, DeBary and Orange City to Daytona Beach and other east-side cities.

This would eliminate the long-distance charges that now apply for Sprint customers. Sprint callers would pay a rate similar to the 25-cent calling now available between DeLand and Daytona Beach.

DeBary resident Cathy Senior, among the Sprint customers in DeBary, said flat-rate calling would be a welcome change from the phone frustration she has known for the past five years.

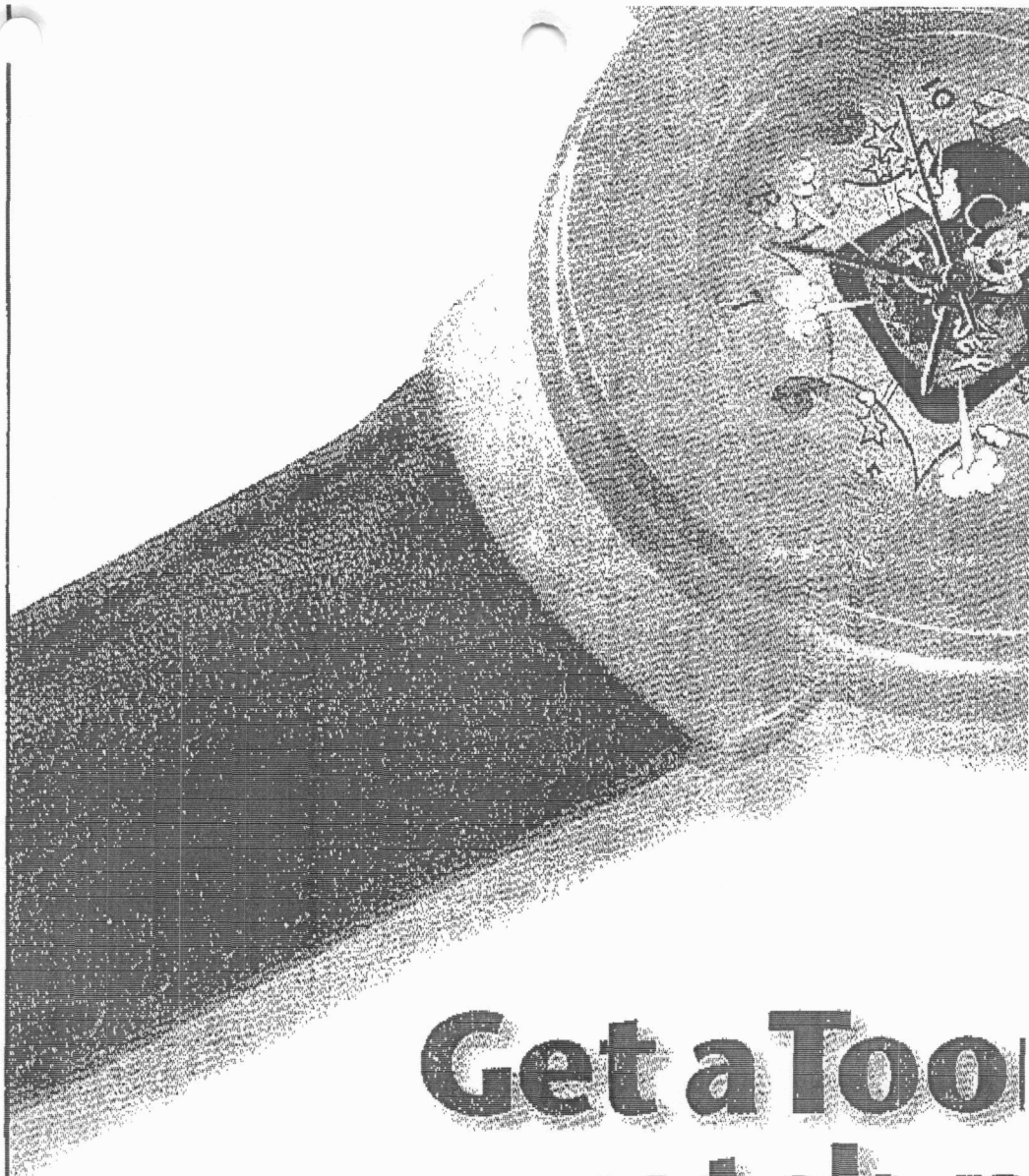
"I think that it's an asset to this community because we hesitate to call our families and friends, and even our workplace, because it's a long-distance phone call," she said.

Customers served by BellSouth in Deltona and DeBary will continue to pay long-distance fees for calling the east side of the county. And anyone in east Volusia calling into southwest Volusia still will pay for a long-distance call, too.

When it meets July 21, the commission will decide whether Sprint customers get the flat-fee call that BellSouth customers won't, or to scrap the idea. The flat rate might be 25 cents for residents. Businesses likely will pay 10 cents for the first minute and 6 cents for each additional minute.

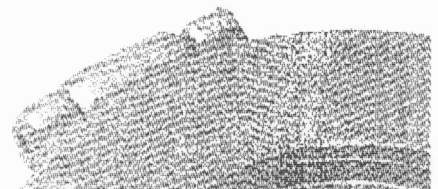
