In accordance with the April 16, 2001 Order, a refund of \$1,030,401.16, including interest of \$183,502.31 was calculated for former customers of the North Ft. Myers Division of Florida Cities Water Company. Refunds and interest were calculated in accordance with the Order and Rules for Refunds.

Refund checks were mailed to 2,117 customers on the system as of November 13, 1999 on May 16, 2001 in accordance with the Order. These refund checks totaled \$745,897.64, including interest of \$132,839.13.

Additionally during May the Refund was advertised, on May 3, 10, 17 and 24 in the Ft. Myers News-Press, in accordance with the Order. Former customers who did not receive a refund check because they were not on the system as of November 13, 1999 had their refund calculated, with interest, and a refund check was mailed to them in accordance with the Order. As of October 15, 2001, 27 customers had contacted us regarding a refund and as a result additional refund checks, including interest; totaling \$5,416.55 has been mailed.

As of October 15, 2001, 2,144 checks totaling \$751,314.19 have been issued. As of December 31, 2001, 45 checks totaling \$10,011.57 had not cleared the bank account. As of October 15, 2001 9 checks, totaling \$2,542.04, were returned as undeliverable and we were unsuccessful at finding alternative addresses. These are included in the outstanding checks.

As of December 31, 2001, a total of 98.6% of the checks mailed have either cleared the bank or been returned as undeliverable.

A check in the amount of \$278,929.36 representing 1,998 accounts was issued to the Office of the Comptroller representing all refunds for which an initial check was not prepared in accordance with the Order, less any customers that requested a refund. Also a check in the amount of \$2,542.04 representing 9 checks that were mailed but returned and we could not find a better address was also issued to the Office of the Comptroller. A copy of both checks is attached. The Office of the Comptroller was subsequently supplied a listing of these refund checks in the manner and on the media they required.
