The information that is the subject of this request is contained in Sprint's Supplemental Response to Verizon's First Set of Interrogatories.

- 3. The confidential information is identified by yellow highlighting. The information for which the Request is submitted is highly proprietary competitive information and thus meets the definition of confidential proprietary business information pursuant to Section 364.183(3)(a)(d) & (e), Florida Statutes. Section 364.183(3), provides:
 - (3) The term "proprietary confidential business information" means information, regardless of form or characteristics, which is owned or controlled by the person or company, is intended to be and is treated by the person or company as private in that the disclosure of the information would cause harm to the ratepayers or the person's or company's business operations, and has not been disclosed unless disclosed pursuant to a statutory provision, an order of a court or administrative body, or private agreement that provides that the information will not be released to the public. The term includes, but is not limited to:
 - (a) Trade secrets.
 - (b) Internal auditing controls and reports of internal auditors.
 - (c) Security measures, systems, or procedures.
 - (d) Information concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the company or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms.
 - (e) Information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of information.
 - (f) Employee personnel information unrelated to compensation, duties, qualifications, or responsibilities.
- 4. Sprint has treated and intends to treat the subject information as private and this information has not been publicly disclosed. Furthermore, the information is sensitive competitive information and disclosure of such information could cause harm to the company's competitive business interests.

5. The confidential information that is the subject of this request is identical to the information contained in Sprint's Supplemental Response to Verizon's First Set of Interrogatories, Response to Interrogatory No. 21, which was filed pursuant to a Request for Confidentiality on January 11, 2002.

Based on the foregoing, Sprint respectfully requests that the Commission grant the request for Confidential Classification, exempt the information from disclosure under Chapter 119, Florida Statutes and issue any appropriate protective order, protecting the information from disclosure.
