> FEA's basic position is preliminary and based on review of materials filed by the parties and on discovery filed to date. FEA believes several of the revenue requirement components that contribute to Gulf Power's (GP) requested \$69.9 million rate increase are unreasonable. The revenue requirement components that are unreasonable include return on equity, depreciation rates, distribution operation and maintenance expenses, and non-fuel production operation and maintenance expenses. FEA further believes the GP Cost of Service and Rate Design Schedules with Minimum Distribution System Methodology is appropriate and consistent with the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners guide book, Electric Utility Cost Allocation Manual.
