The purpose of this memo is to request that Docket 010789-EI be closed administratively. At the Agenda Conference held on February 19, 2002, the Commission voted to accept Staff's recommendation in Docket 010789-EI, thereby requiring that a PAA order be issued in the docket by March 11, 2002. On February 25, 2002, at the hearing in Docket 010949-EI (Gulf Rate Case), the Commission voted to accept a stipulation resolving issues relevant to both Docket Nos. 010949-EI and 010789-EI. As part of the vote to accept the stipulation, the Commission also voted to recognize that the vote to accept the stipulation rendered moot the vote on February 19, 2002, to approve the recommendation in Docket No. 010789-EI, and to close Docket 010789-EI administratively.
