DECLARATION

Ed Cahill, Vice President of AES Coral, hereby states as follows:

- 1. I am the Vice President of AES Coral.
- 2. AES submitted bid proposals in response to FPL's request for proposals issued on August 13, 2001 ("RFP").
- 3. I have read AES' Motion for Protective Order. I can confirm that the factual matters asserted therein regarding the sensitive competitive nature of the confidential information that is the subject of the Motion, and the harm that AES would auffer if the confidential information is produced to any of the Intervenors in the FPL Need Determination dockets (Consolidated Docket Nos. 020262 EI and 020263-EI).
- 4. I understand that FPL has issued a supplemental RFP last week (the "Supplemental RFP"). Presumably, many entities that submitted bid responses to the original RFP will submit bid proposals to the Supplemental RFP.
- 5. The issuance of the Supplemental RFP makes AES' need for a protective order even more compelling. Allowing Intervenors to have access to AES' bid proposals prior to submitting their responses to the Supplemental RFP puts Non-Intervenors such as AES at a significant competitive disadvantage.
- 6. Allowing Intervenors to have access to AES' confidential information at this time would severely harm AES and its ability to compete, not only in Florida, but also in its other global markets.
