This docket involves a territory amendment application filed by Florida Water Services Corporation ("Florida Water"). The original application included several parcels proposed to be added to Florida Water's existing service territory in Lake County. Since the filing of the application, it has been determined that certain portions of the requested new territory do not have a current need for service. Accordingly, Florida Water submits the enclosed revised tariff sheets which include only those portions of the originally requested territory for which there is a current need for service. In other words, the legal description from the original application is being amended to delete those areas where there is not a current need for service.
