FLORIDA POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY'S REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION OF CERTAIN DOCUMENTS AND INFORMATION RESPONSIVE TO STAFF'S FIRST REQUEST FOR PRODUCTION OF DOCUMENTS (NOS. 7 AND 9-11), SECOND SET OF INTERROGATORIES (NOS. 34-36, 49 AND 50), AND THIRD SET OF INTERROGATORIES (NOS. 54, 61-63, 65-67, 77 AND 79)

Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, F.A.C., and Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, requests confidential classification of certain documents and information responsive to Requests No. 7 and 9-11 of Staff's First Request for Production of Documents, Interrogatories No. 34-36, 49 and 50 of Staff's Second Set of Interrogatories and Interrogatories No. 54, 61-63, 65-67, 77 and 79 of Staff's Third Set of Interrogatories (the "Confidential Discovery Responses"). In support of its Request, FPL states as follows:

1. FPL provided to Staff the documents and information responsive to Staff's First Request for Production of Documents and Second Set of Interrogatories on October 14, 2002. Contemporaneously, FPL filed a Notice of Intent to Seek Confidential Classification. FPL provided to Staff the documents and information responsive to Staff's Third Set of Interrogatories on October 21, 2002, and again filed contemporaneously a Notice of Intent to Seek Confidential Classification. All of the Confidential Discovery Responses are covered by either the October 14 Notice of Intent or the October 21 Notice of Intent. Rule 25-22.006, F.A.C. provides that, unless good cause is shown for delay, a party that has filed a notice of intent must then file a request for confidential classification of the information covered by the

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notice of intent within 21 days. This Request is being filed within 21 days of FPL's filing the October 14 and October 21 Notices of Intent, and is intended to request confidential classification of the Confidential Discovery Responses consistent with Rule 25-22.006.

- 2. The following exhibits are included with this Request:
- a. Composite Exhibit A consists of a copy of the Confidential Discovery Responses, in which all information that FPL asserts is entitled to confidential treatment has been highlighted. Composite Exhibit A is submitted separately in a sealed folder marked "CONFIDENTIAL."
- b. Composite Exhibit B consists of two copies of the Confidential Discovery Responses in which all information that FPL asserts is entitled to confidential treatment has been redacted.
- c. Exhibit C is a table containing a line-by-line and page-by-page identification of the information in the Confidential Discovery Responses for which confidential treatment is sought, together with references to the specific statutory basis for the claim of confidentiality and to the affidavits in support of the requested classification. Exhibit C is sometimes referred to hereinafter as the "Justification Table."
- d. Exhibit D consists of the affidavits of Keyvan Bohlooli, Director of Systems Operations & Administration for FPL's Energy Marketing & Trading Division, and Joseph P. Stepenovitch, Director of FPL's Energy Marketing & Trading Division. The affidavits attest to the asserted basis for confidential classification.
- 4. FPL seeks confidential protection for the information highlighted in Exhibit A. The highlighted information is confidential because it (a) comprises trade secrets of FPL, which

allow FPL to conduct its fuel procurement on favorable terms for FPL and its customers, and/or (b) comprises information relating to the competitive interests of vendors that FPL has agreed to protect as confidential. Disclosure of FPL's trade-secret information would provide other participants in the fuel markets insight into FPL's fuel-procurement practices that would allow them to anticipate FPL's procurement decisions and/or impair FPL's ability to negotiate, to the detriment of FPL and its customers. See § 366.093(3)(a), Fla. Stat (2001) Disclosure of the information relating to vendors' competitive interests would violate FPL's commitments to protect the confidentiality of the vendor information and would impair FPL's ability to purchase goods and services in the future that require disclosure of vendors' competitive information because the vendors would not be confident that such information would be adequately protected. See § 366.093(3)(e), Fla. Stat (2001)

- 5. FPL submits that the highlighted information is proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of Section 366.093(3). Pursuant to Section 366.093, such information is entitled to confidential treatment and is exempt from the disclosure provisions of the public records law.
- 6. The material in Exhibit A for which FPL seeks confidential classification is intended to be and is treated by FPL as private, and its confidentiality has been maintained.
- 7. Upon a finding by the Commission that the material in Exhibit A for which FPL seeks confidential treatment is proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of Section 366.093(3), pursuant to Section 366.093(4) such materials should not be declassified for at least eighteen (18) months and should be returned to FPL as soon as the information is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business.

WHEREFORE, FPL respectfully requests that its Request for Confidential Classification of the Confidential Discovery Responses be granted.
