On October 10, 2002, by Order No. PSC-02-1409-NOR-TP, the Florida Public Service Commission issued it Notice of Rulemaking in the instant proceeding. This Notice was the culmination of more than one year of workshops, discussions and negotiations among the parties regarding the Commission's proposed rulemaking regarding notice to be provided to customers. On November 8, 2002, the American Association of Retired Persons (AARP) filed comments on the proposed rule.
