Dear Mr. Jaeger:

Your staff has raised a question about the scope of Section 4.5 of the proposed agreement between Clay Electric Cooperative, Inc. and the City of Gainesville, d/b/a Gainesville Regional Utilities (GRU), which is the subject of this docket. Clay Electric and GRU do not envision this provision as creating any issue that would lead to further uneconomic duplication of distribution facilities of either utility. The intent of the parties is to preserve the right, in appropriate circumstances, of a party to serve its own facilities (not facilities owned by an end use customer) when to do so would be consistent with prudent utility practice, safety factors, and sound engineering practices. There may be instances where facilities that are designed to increase the reliability of a party's system may need to be built in or through a portion of the other party's service area. It is not the intent of either party that this provision be used as a means to avoid the policy against uneconomic duplication of facilities.


