CASE BACKGROUND

Forest Utilities, Inc. (Forest or utility) is a Class B wastewater-only utility in Lee County. As of December 31, 2000, the utility served 2,032 wastewater customers and reported operating revenues of \$645,507 and a net operating loss of \$47,633.

On December 31, 2001, the utility filed an application to increase its system capacity charge. This recommendation addresses the suspension of the utility's proposed tariff sheets. The Commission has jurisdiction pursuant to Section 367.101, Florida Statutes.
