



I have been waiting for over a year for BellSouth to provision DSL Internet access (marketed as "FastAccess") in my service area. BellSouth advertises the service heavily, but when I try to sign-up I am told the service is not available on my phone line. No one has been able to tell me when it will be available. It appears the service is all advertising and no substance.

Provisioning the service is technically feasible, but BellSouth does not seem interested in doing it. However, they continue to make it difficult and cost prohibitive for third party suppliers to implement the service. I'm sure they would rather have me pay the exorbitant costs of a second slow access line instead if provisioning high-speed access and a phone line over the same service.

May I have the Commission's help in mandating BellSouth provisioning of the service in my area?

comments: I hope this is the right area to file this complaint. I attempted to get xDSL internet service through Bell South. They told me they couldn't provide me service because I was outside of the service area. I then ordered xDSL internet service from an internet service provider by the name of SpeakEasy.net. This service is offered through another backbone provider by the name of Covad. Both of these companies have been very helpful and cooperative. In their notice to me of my installation I was advised as follows:

Covad has just informed us of your telephone delivery date of:

November, 02 2000

This is when the phone company makes a copper circuit or "loop" available for your DSL circuit. You will need to be at your house if your phone box (also called a NID) is located inside your house/garage, is difficult to access, or if you live on the East Coast. We apologize to the undue inconvenience to our East Coast customers, but Bell Atlantic and Bell South's tactics of calling all missed loop installs no access issues is forcing us to make this a necessary step until Covad corrects this matter with them. If you have any questions about the location of your phone box, please refer to our Frequently Asked Questions at:

I stayed home on November 2, 2000 until such time as my niece came to my house to relieve me so that I could go to work. She was there until my son came home from work at 4:00 PM. Both are over the age of 21, and as such able to provide access. The thing is there is no need for access. The NID's on all the houses in the complex are located on the front of the building and readily accessible. This is a clear case of harrassment on the part of

Bell South to cause problems for their area competitors, even though they acknowledge that they can't provide service with their current technology. I think and would hope that the PSC would investigate their anti-competitive actions and take what action the law allows. I believe this kind of activity should be considered the next time that Bell South comes before the PSC. This amounts to nothing less than the very kind of activity that the Federal Justice Department prosecuted Microsoft for. A predatory monopolistic corporation causing undue difficulty for their small competitors, and causing harm to the general public as well. This kind of reprehensible behavior by Bell South should not be tolerated by either the public or the PSC.
