SPECIAL DETAIL AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into this 30h of April, 2003 by and between Ed Dean, as Sheriff of Marion County, Florida, (SHERIFF), located at 692 NW 30th Avenue Ocala, Florida 34475, and Florida Public Service Commission located at 2540 Shumard Oak Blvd. Tallahassee, FL. 32399.



WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Florida State Statutes allow the SHERIFF to operate a program to contract for the employment of sheriff's deputies during off-duty hours, for public or private security services consistent with Sheriff's Office policies, and

WHEREAS, the SHERIFF is not obligated to provide such services but wishes to do so in order to provide a means for which the citizens of Marion County may have an opportunity to supplement other law enforcement services; and

WHEREAS, BUSINESS desires to hire a deputy during off-duty hours for supplemental security purposes;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants, and conditions herein contained, the parties contract and agree as follows:

1. **DURATION**:

This agreement shall remain in effect for one year from the date set forth above, unless it is recinded or terminated in writing by either party.

2. PAYMENT:

- a) Full payment is due in advance, unless prior arrangements have been made. Payment may be paid by check or money order payable to the MARION COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE, Post Office Box 1987, Ocala, FL 34478. If payment is not received, SHERIFF will discontinue providing off-duty deputies. BUSINESS understands that individual deputies are not paid until payment is made by BUSINESS.
- b) BUSINESS agrees to pay SHERIFF \$25.00 per hour per deputy, with a three hour minimum per deputy.

3. CANCELLATION:

a) BUSINESS shall notify SHERIFF of any cancellations within a reasonable time and understands that failure to do so allows the SHERIFF, at his discretion, to bill for the minimum three hours per deputy.

b) SHERIFF agrees to make all reasonable efforts to fill any special detail requests; however, BUSINESS agrees not to hold SHERIFF liable for any consequential damages resulting from the SHERIFF'S inability to do so.

4. **LIABILITY**:

BOTH PARTIES recognize and agree that pursuant to state statute, the hiring of off-duty deputies may result in a claim for property damage, bodily and personal injury, including a claim for worker's compensation against BUSINESS, except that any deputy sheriff injured while enforcing the criminal, traffic or penal laws of this state shall be regarded as working on duty and would be covered under SHERIFF'S insurance, including workers compensation.

5. <u>INDEMNIFICATION</u>

BUSINESS agrees that it will defend, indemnify and hold harmless the SHERIFF, his heirs, successors in interest or insurers from any and all claims, actions, judgments and suits, including a claim for workers compensation arising from or in connection with any act or omission of said Deputy Sheriff(s) while acting on his behalf and to his benefit and within the course and scope of such employment, together with any costs, attorney's fees or other expenses incurred or to be incurred by SHERIFF, or the County of Marion, in the defense of any such claim, action, judgment or suit, including the enforcement of this Agreement, whether such claim be groundless or not.

6. **COVERAGE**:

BUSINESS agrees that SHERIFF reserves the right to require that a sufficient number of deputies be employed at large, public events to ensure safe and efficient law enforcement coverage.

Read the Special Detail Agreement (indemnification agreement), initial the first page, sign and have witnessed the second page. Read the Special Detail Request Form, check for accuracy making any changes necessary, fill in where marked by an X and initial in the "requested by" space. Fax both pages of the Special detail Agreement, and the Special Request Form back to the Special Details Coordinator as soon as possible at 352-236-7165. If fax is not available, mail everything back to Special Details Coordinator at the Marion County Sheriff's Office, PO Box 1987, Ocala, FL 34478, and attention Lucille Hervey.
- The Marion County Sheriff's Office is NOT obligated to provide additional law enforcement services. Such services will not be provided to any person, firm or organization whose officers, members, business or operations are questionable, or for any event of a potentially compromising nature, as determined by the Sheriff or designee.
- The Special Details Coordinator reserves the right to require a minimum number of deputies for any detail, after considering the following factors:
 - a. Location of the detail
 - b. Nature of the detail
 - c. Anticipated crowd size
 - Large Public Events Protocol: The Officer In Charge (OIC), or designee, will arrive at least 30 minutes before the rest of the assigned deputies. Upon arrival the OIC will perform a walk around visual check of the event area for any suspicious packages or items. This protocol is for our ongoing efforts of public safety.

- d. Past problems
- e. Available intelligence information
- f. Risk assessment
- g. Feedback from district commanders
- All special detail requests are subject to approval by the Patrol Bureau Chief, with final approval by the Sheriff. Upon approval, every attempt will be made to fill your request. As special details are considered extra duty, and are worked by deputies on their off duty time, there is a chance that we may not be able to find a deputy willing to work. You will be notified in advance if we are unable to fill your request.
- All compensation due for services performed may be by check or money order, payable to the ED DEAN, MARION COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE, attention Lucille Hervey, Special Details Coordinator. Cash payments are not accepted. Payment is due in advance unless prior arrangements have been made (upon filling your request, you will be sent a statement which you can pay in advance, or pay the deputy at the end of the detail). If unforeseen circumstances arise which cause the deputy to work longer then the set times, you will be billed. Any compensation over and above the established rate is prohibited. The current rate per deputy is \$25.00 per hour with a three hour minimum. (This rate covers the deputy, insurance, taxes, and equipment).

I appeal the Pinellas County proposed rates change and charge change for water.

We have a home in Pinellas County, FL. We are charged a very high minimum charge even when we are have no water usage for months at a time. We are given the excuse "it is there if you need it and is considered available so there needs to be a high charge".

With the water problems from too little water and too many people, it seems that you have a backward rationale. You need to reward no monthly water usage customers instead of moniterally penalizing them. We are seriously considering applying a timer to our sprinkler system to use up our minimum water quota so we can get our money's worth by watering our lawn while we are not there. Does that make environmental sense considering how valuable water is? No, but I know of those who do exactly that because the feel violated by being charged such a high minimum for the months they don't use any water at all. Perhaps if they were rewarded for conserving water, they would not use water for their lawns when they are not even there.

Also needs to be considered that not all water used goes into the sewer system but we are charged as if it does.

I think the rate charged for water is quite enough now and I ask that you not even seriously consider a rate increase. Also you need to rectify the high minimum with no usage charge.

Utilities, Inc. of Florida (UIF or utility) is a water and wastewater utility providing service to 23 systems in Marion, Orange, Pasco, Pinellas and Seminole Counties. Separate rate structures apply to each of these counties. The utility serves approximately 6,850 water customers and 2,541 wastewater customers, according to UIF's year-end 2001 Annual Report. Most of these water and wastewater customers reside in Pasco and Seminole Counties.

On June 28, 2002, UIF filed an application for both interim and permanent rate increases. Subsequently, the utility amended its application several times, most recently on April 14, 2003. Overall, UIF has requested an interim increase of \$376,902 and, in accordance with Section 367.082, Florida Statutes (the statute dealing with interim rate increases for water and wastewater companies), the PSC approved interim increases totaling \$30,580 for the Marion, Orange and Pinellas County water systems, as well as an interim increase of \$202,023 for the Seminole County wastewater systems. These interim rates are to become effective once UIF fulfills its customer noticing requirements, and the interim increase is subject to refund following the completion of the PSC's investigation of the utility's request.

The total revenue increase requested by UIF is \$509,776 for its water systems and \$520,015 for its wastewater systems, or a total of \$1,029,791. This increase is based on the utility's request for overall rates of return ranging, by county, from 9.10 percent to 9.34 percent.

The PSC has scheduled three customer service hearings to provide customers the opportunity to comment on UIF's rates and services. The PSC will consider the utility's rates, expenses, quality of service, and other matters in this case.

PSC staff is currently scheduled to make a recommendation to the Commission on November 13, 2003, and the Commission vote on this matter is currently scheduled for November 25, 2003.


