Supra Telecommunications & Information Systems, Inc. ("Supra") is a **minority-owned Alternative Local Exchange Carrier (ALEC)** duly certified in 10 states to perform local and long distance service as a result of the Telecommunications Act of 1996. Supra is pursuing an exciting course implementing its plans to become a major nationwide player in the telecommunications industry by providing new and innovative local and long distance services at lower rates to customers.

Supra hereby requests your assistance in any form that you find appropriate to aid Supra to fight the discriminatory and anti-competitive behavior exhibited by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (BellSouth) throughout Supra's efforts over the past year to become established as an ALEC. Our company is being severely handicapped by BellSouth's obstructionist and dilatory tactics in the negotiation of an acceptable interconnection agreement and in the collocation of our switching equipment in BellSouth's central offices.

Mr. President, on February 8, 1996, at the signing ceremony for the Telecommunications Act of 1996, you stated that "this law is truly revolutionary legislation that will bring the future to our doorstep." By this Act, you and the U.S. Congress threw down the gauntlet to those of us that wanted to compete in the provision of local telecommunications services. This is a challenge that Supra gladly accepted. Since then we have worked day and night, practically 24 hours a day seven days a week, non-stop for two years.

To try to fight back against BellSouth's discriminatory and anti-competitive behavior, Supra filed a complaint against BellSouth with the Florida Public Service Commission in January 1998. This matter is docketed by the Florida Public Service Commission as Docket No. 980119-TP. The hearing was held on April 30, 1998. The Florida Public Service Commission will vote on the issues in this proceeding on June 30, 1998. The full transcript of that proceeding is available on the Florida Public Service Commission's web site at <http://www2.scri.net/psc/audio.html>. Simply refer to Docket No. 980119-TP, Supra Telecommunications & Information Systems, Inc. vs. BellSouth. The transcript of the proceeding provides numerous examples of BellSouth's disparate treatment of Supra as opposed to its treatment of AT&T and MCI, for example. It also reflects BellSouth's efforts against all ALEC and CLEC competition.

Mr. President, BellSouth's actions violate Sections 104, 251, and 252 of the Telecommunications Act. Section 104 of the Telecommunications Act, the Nondiscrimination Principle, reads:

Section 1 (47 U.S.C. 151) is amended by inserting after 'to all people of the United States' the following: 'without discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, or sex.'

Mr. President, in your remarks at the University of California at San Diego's Commencement Ceremony, on June 14, 1997, you said:

But I believe the greatest challenge we face, among all those that Colleen talked about, is also our greatest opportunity. Of all the questions of discrimination and prejudice that still exist in our society, the most perplexing one is the oldest, and in some ways today, the newest: the problem of race. Can we fulfill the promise of America by embracing all our citizens of all races, not just at a university where people have the benefit of enlightened teachers and the time to think and grow and get to know each other within the daily life of every American community? In short, can we become one America in the 21st century?

First, we must continue to expand opportunity. Full participation in our strong and growing economy is the best antidote to envy, despair and racism. However, BellSouth has not filed these exemptions with the Florida Public Service Commission subsequent to the passage of the Telecommunications Act, which it was required to do if BellSouth wished to keep such exemptions. To permit BellSouth to prohibit Supra access to these two central offices based on exemptions obtained prior to the passage of the Telecommunications Act is to permit BellSouth to frustrate the intent and purpose of the Act. These two central offices are crucial to Supra's success and BellSouth knows it.

If Supra is forced to litigate against BellSouth to gain access to these two central offices, Supra's planned roll-out of its services will be seriously delayed well beyond the September 30, 1998, deadline in Supra's business plan. This business plan has been carefully crafted to permit Supra to begin providing local and long distance services across the State of Florida very soon. Many business decisions have been based on this time line.

Supra is motivated, determined and possesses in depth knowledge of the telecommunications industry. We have a highly committed and knowledgeable team. We know how to run a phone company. We are ready to face the challenges ahead of us. We are committed to innovation and constant improvement.


Supra has negotiated a \$1.3 billion equipment purchase commitment with Lucent Technologies. Supra is ready, willing, and able to invest and compete if





On May 9, 2000, the United States District court for the Northern District of Florida dismissed BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc.'s (BellSouth) lawsuit against Supra Telecommunications & Information Systems, Inc. (Supra) and Commissioners Deason, Garcia and Jacobs in their official capacities as Commissioners of the Florida Public Service Commission. BellSouth had sought, and the Court agreed, to dismiss the case without prejudice or payment of attorneys fees. Supra had asked for attorneys fees and had opposed BellSouth's motion for dismissal without prejudice. The Commission had supported BellSouth's motion.

As noted by the Court in its Order, p. 1-2, the action which has been dismissed was

More specifically, this federal litigation appealed Commission requirements that BellSouth provide on-line edit checking capability to Supra. The Commission's Answer Brief challenged BellSouth's contentious concerning the issue of providing on-line edit checking capabilities to Supra. The Answer Brief also pointed out that this federal appeal, by divesting the Commission of jurisdiction, was the primary obstacle to the Commission's ability to assess BellSouth's compliance with the on-line edit checking requirement in the appealed orders - PSC-98-1001-FOF-TP and PSC-98-1467-FOF-TP.

Supra Telecommunications & Information Systems, Inc., a competitor. BellSouth has moved for voluntary dismissal of its complaint. Supra opposes the motion.

The standards governing such motions for voluntary dismissal are set forth in Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(2) and McCants v. Ford Motor Co., 781 F.2d 855, 856-57 (11th Cir. 1986). Under McCants, voluntary dismissal ordinarily should be granted unless the opposing party will suffer "clear legal prejudice" as a result. Supra has shown no "clear legal prejudice" it will suffer from dismissal of this case. To the contrary, any dismissal will impose on Supra at most the possibility that it will be required to defend another action raising the same claims, even assuming that, following dismissal of this action, BellSouth would again be free to bring another similar action. This is no more prejudice than the defendant faced in McCants and no more prejudice than any defendant faces in any case voluntarily dismissed without prejudice prior to the running of the applicable statute of limitations. McCants makes clear that this is not enough to preclude dismissal.

Supra also seems to assert that dismissal will delay enforcement of the Commission's decision. Supra has made no claim in this court, however, for enforcement of the Commission's decision, and it is not at all clear there would be jurisdiction here of any such claim for enforcement. Moreover, if BellSouth's complaint is dismissed, the Florida Public Service Commission's decision will remain in force, at least unless and until altered by the Commission itself or challenged in any timely new lawsuit. The Commission will remain free to enforce its decision exactly as if this lawsuit had never been filed.

Finally, Supra seeks an award of attorney's fees as a condition of dismissal, as authorized by Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(2). Supra makes no assertion, however, that it has incurred fees for work that will not be useful in the event BellSouth refiles this litigation. If BellSouth does not refile, Supra will have won, but in fairness ought not recover fees that it would have been unable to recover had BellSouth gone the distance and lost

on the merits.¹ If BellSouth refiles, the attorney's fees Supra has incurred will not need to be replicated; the work that has been done will, for the most part, be useable in the new case. In short, while BellSouth's filing of this case has caused Supra to incur attorney's fees, BellSouth's voluntary dismissal of its case has cut off the running of those fees and has not imposed any significant additional fees on Supra. As a matter of discretion, I will not condition voluntary dismissal on BellSouth's reimbursement of Supra's attorney's fees.


For these reasons,

IT IS ORDERED:

¹ Rule 41(a)(2) is not designed to give a plaintiff an incentive to be stubbornly litigious and pursue a case to the bitter end just to avoid an award of attorney's fees. Ordinarily, in a case involving no fee statute or contract or other basis for an award of fees to the winner, a plaintiff who decides to give up ought not be worse off than a plaintiff who goes the distance and loses. A plaintiff who voluntarily dismisses in order to be able to refile ordinarily should be required to bear the fees caused by this tactic, but not the fees that would be incurred in defending the case if filed and litigated to conclusion in a single action. All of this is tempered by discretion and the circumstances of the case; what is "ordinarily" appropriate is not appropriate in all cases.

Plaintiff's motion for voluntary dismissal without prejudice is GRANTED. The clerk shall enter judgment stating, "Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(2), this action is dismissed without prejudice." The clerk shall close the file.






