

On Monday, January 24, 2000, our client, AT&T Corp., filed a petition protesting the Florida Public Service Commission's intended decision to award the Florida Relay Service System Contract ("the FRS System Contract") to Sprint. In an abundance of caution, a protest bond in the amount of \$5,000 was submitted along with the petition. However, the Commission's authority to select the provider of the telecommunications relay service arises from section 427.704(3), Florida Statutes, rather than from authority delegated by the Department of Management Services pursuant to chapter 287, Florida Statutes. Since section 427.704 neither requires vendors challenging a procurement decision to post a protest bond, nor authorizes the Commission to require such a bond, we hereby request that the bond that accompanied the AT&T petition be immediately returned to this office, for forwarding to AT&T.



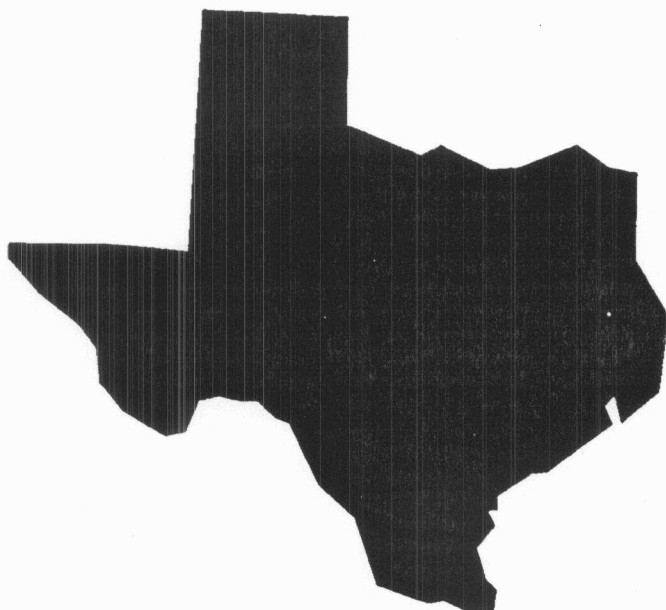

The Deaf, hard of hearing, and late deafened telecommunication customers in the state of The Florida The telecommunication relay customers have been addressing two most important issues regarding to the state Florida Relay Service.

The state of Florida does not provide equal access to telecommunication services that people with normal hearing have.

(1) Deaf and Hard of Hearing customers have already subscribed to a Caller-ID services with their telephone service provider. The Florida Relay Service (Sprint) has the capability to provide this service and this service is not available to Deaf, late deafened, and hard of hearing customers in Florida. The use of Caller-ID to screen incoming calls is an essential tool of Deaf, late deafened, and hard of hearing telecommunication customers.

(2) Deaf and Hard of Hearing customers do not have the capability to control phone conversations because there is no "two-way" call interruption mode. This means a customer will have to wait until the conversation is completed before they decide to take action. This is the most common problem with voice mail and if a person reads what the Florida Relay Operator typed on the screen and the menu options which the customer wants to enter, but will have to wait until the operator is done typing the information on the TTY. With a Turbo Code option, a person can interrupt and make a selection to speed up TTY phone calls.

The rationale behind the Caller-ID and Turbo Code is that a Deaf, late deafened, and hard of hearing customers have a right to functional

communication equivalency as they paid for the phone services. Title IV of the American Disabilities Act: Section 64.601 Definitions. (7) Telecommunications relay service (TRS). Telephone transmission services that provide the ability for an individual who has a hearing of speech disability to engage in communication by wire or radio with a hearing individual who does not have a hearing or speech disability to communicate using voice communication services by wire or radio.

Turbo Code uses ASCII and Baudot format and most telecommunication TTY customers type above 60 words per minute and the normal TTY Baudot mode does not permit this because the speed limit is up to 45.5 Baudot. Turbo Code allows us to type faster and complete the conversation quicker. Section 64.604 Mandatory Minimum Standards. (b) Technical Standards. (1) ASCII and Baudot. TRS shall be capable of communication with ASCII and Baudot format, AT ANY SPEED GENERALLY IN USE. (emphasis added). Section 64.604 Mandatory Minimum Standards. (5) Technology. No regulation set forth in this subpart is intended to discourage or impair the development of improved technology that fosters the availability of telecommunications to persons with disabilities.

The Florida Telecommunications Relay, Inc. (FTRI) have been providing telecommunication devices for all Deaf, late deafened, and hard of hearing telecommunication customers in the state of Florida also all of the telecommunication devices have Turbo Code option.

The Florida Public Service Commission needs to be aware the issue of functional equivalency is the utmost concern because it helps to speed up calls, gives the telecommunication customers more control of their calls and mostly it gives them the independence that enables them to use the services such as hearing counterparts have.

In closing, we ask the Florida Public Service Commission to provide these services to the telecommunication customers as soon as possible which will enable them to use these services which will enhance their calling productivity using the Florida Relay Service.

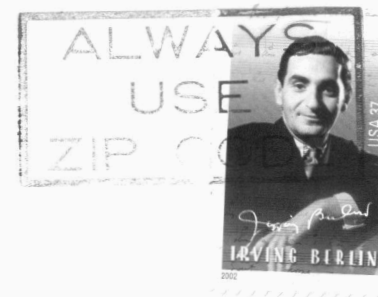


