

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Introduction

The purpose of this filing is to obsolete BellSouth's Telephone Answering Service (TAS).

Description of TAS

TAS is an equipment configuration provided to telephone answering agencies/secretarial bureaus which provide telephone answering, monitoring, and/or dispatching services to clients (typically including doctors, service companies, and understaffed offices) when they are absent or don't choose to answer calls personally.

Customer Impact

There are currently 626 TAS customers in Florida. These services will continue to be available to existing customers for inward activity only. This service will not be available for new service/systems or moves of entire systems to a new location.
