ORDER GRANTING ADDITIONAL
TIME TO FILE TRAFFIC STUDY

On August 6, 1987, we issued Order No. 17943, which among other things, required ALLTEL Florida, Inc. (ALLTEL) to provide certain traffic studies applicable to Gilchrist County for the Commission's review. In accordance with Rule 25-4.060, Florida Administrative Code, we required the studies to be completed and filed on or before October 5, 1987.

On September 28, 1987, ALLTEL filed a Motion for Extension of Time to file the required study. ALLTEL indicated it will not be able to file the required data by October 5, 1987. ALLTEL has requested an extension of thirty (30) days to complete the traffic study and analysis.

We find that ALLTEL's request is not made to delay this proceeding, nor that any party will be adversely affected by the request. Therefore, we hereby grant the requested extension.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by Commissioner John T. Herndon, as Prehearing Officer, that ALLTEL Florida, Inc. shall file the required traffic study within thirty (30) days of the date of this order.
