## AMENDED ORDER

The purpose of this Order is to correctly reflect the portions of Document No. 11614-88 that are being granted Specified Confidential Treatment.

In consideration of the foregoing, it is

ORDERED that Order No. 20419 is amended to read as follows:

On November 18, 1988, this Commission entered Order No. 20333 in Docket No. 860001-EI-G denying Florida Power Corporation's (FPC) request to treat Documents Nos. 11614-88 and 11615-88 as specified confidential materials. The reason stated in Order No. 20333 was that FPC had not identified with sufficient specificity that portion of the materials that qualified for such treatment.

Subsequent to the entry of Order No. 20333, FPC provided sufficient additional information so as to identify certain portions of Documents Nos. 11614-88 and 11615-88 as specified confidential.

In consideration of the foregoing, it is

ORDERED that the Amended Request for Specified Confidential Treatment is granted for the following portions of Document No. 11614-88:

1. Amounts shown on page 12 (line 21); page 13 (lines 6 and 7); page 15 (lines 16-20); and page 16 (lines 3 and 6).
