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PREHEARING OFFICER'S ORDER ON  
REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIALITY

In this docket concerning Tampa Electric, the petitioner has sought Confidential Classification regarding transportation, transloading, and storage costs associated with Tampa Electric's affiliate. Tampa Electric seeks to protect information in Document No. 745-89 as is required to be filed in the following Commission forms:

- Form 423-1(a): Columns (h)(i)(j)(k)(l)(m)(n)(o)
- Form 423-2(a): Columns (f)(h)(i)(j)(k)(l)
- Form 423.2(b): Columns (g)(i)(k)(l)(m)(n)(o)(p)

The justification asserted by Tampa Electric in support of its motion is that the cost associated with the above contractual data, "would impair the efforts of the public utility to contract for services on favorable terms." (Section 366.093(3) Florida Statute)

In earlier Orders this Commission has consented to the same logic and information proposed in Tampa Electric's present motion. This Commission finds that the above request for Confidential Classification is therefore reasonable.

Now, Therefore, it is

ORDERED by Prehearing Officer, Commissioner John T. Herndon, that the request of Tampa Electric Company, through its counsel James D. Beasley, for confidential status for confidential classification of the aforementioned forms is granted.
