# ORDER AMENDING CERTIFICATES TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL TERRITORY

#### BY THE COMMISSION:

On February 27, 1987, Southern States Utilities, Inc. (Southern States or Utility) filed an application with this Commission to amend Certificates Nos. 84-W and 73-S to include additional territory in Orange County, Florida. Docket No. 861640-WS was opened to consider the application. The City of Winter Park objected to the extension. The objection was rejected by this Commission. Further, the City's appeal to the 1st District Court of Appeals was rejected in August, 1988.

On December 20, 1988, Southern States filed a request seeking reactivation of its application to amend Certificates Nos. 84-W and 73-S to include the additional territory in Orange County, pursuant to the provisions of Section 367.061, Florida Statutes. This Docket (890062-WS) was opened to consider the application.

In its original application, Southern States notified certificated utilities and appropriate governmental agencies in Grange County on December 12 and 15, 1986, of its intention to amend its Certificates to include the territory described in Appendix A, attached to this Order. Proof of Notification has been furnished by the Utility.

Notice of the Utility's intent to extend its service area was published in the Orlando Sentinel, a newspaper of general circulation, published in Orange County, Florida, on December 14, 21, and 28, 1986. As previously mentioned, the objection filed by the City of Winter Park has been rejected. No other objections have been received.

The appropriate filing fee has been paid, and the Utility is ready, willing and able to provide service in the territory for which it has applied. The application has been reviewed and found to be in compliance with the statutory requirements. Accordingly, we find it is in the public interest to amend Certificates Nos. 84-W and 73-S to include the territory described in Appendix A to this Order, which by reference is incorporated herein.

#### It is, therefore,

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Certificates Nos. 84-W and 73-S, held by Southern States Utilities, Inc., 1000 Color Place, Apopka 32703, are hereby amended to include the territory described in Appendix A of this Order. The Utility is directed to return Certificates Nos. 84-W and 73-S to this Commission within 20 days of the date of this Order for appropriate entry. It is further

ORDERED that the customers in the territory added herein shall be charged the rates approved in the Utility's tariff. It is further

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ORDERED that Docket No. 890062-WS is hereby closed.
