On December 6, Florida Power Corporation (FPC) and Pinellas County (County) filed a petition for approval of an interconnection agreement between FPC and the County. This interconnection agreement concerned the County's Mid-County solid waste recovery facility. On January 10, 1989, FPC filed a petition for withdrawal of its interconnection approval petition. FPC has indicated that it will refile this interconnection agreement in the companion docket in which it has requested approval of the negotiated contract for sale of electricity produced by the County's Mid-County facility.

This withdrawal petition has been filed pursuant to Commission Rule 25-22.035(3) and Rule of Civil Procedure 1.420(a)(1). Pursuant to these rules, the complainant can withdraw his petition at any time prior to the submittal of his case to the trier of fact without approval of the court.
