## ORDER CLOSING DOCKET

BY THE COMMISSION:

On February 13, 1989, the City of Palm Bay (City) timely filed an objection to the proposed extension of water service noticed by General Development Utilities, Port Malabar Division (utility). The utility also published notice of its intent to extend its wastewater service; however, the City did not object to that portion of the notice. This docket was opened to process the City's objection.

By letter dated March 13, 1989, the utility withdrew its notice of the proposed water extension which was the subject of the City's objection. The utility also stated that it does not intend to notice a proposed extension of water service to that same area in the future. In a letter from the City received by this Commission on March 27, 1989, the City concurred with the utility's request to withdraw its proposed water extension and reiterated that it had no objection to the utility's intention to extend its wastewater service.

Since the objection has been resolved, this docket can be closed. The extension of the utility's wastewater service will be processed administratively in another docket when the utility files its application pursuant to Section 367.061, Florida Statutes.

Based on the foregoing, it is
