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25-24.510 Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity Required.

No person shall provide pay telephone service without first obtaining a certificate of public convenience and necessity from the Commission. Services may not be provided, nor may deposits or payment for services be collected until the effective date of a certificate, if granted. However, acquisition of equipment and facilities, advertising and other promotional activities may begin prior to the effective date of the certificate at the company's risk that it may not be granted. In any customer contacts or advertisements advertises prior to certification, the company must advise the customer that certification has not and may never be granted.

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25-24.512 Improper Use of a Certificate.

(1) No certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing pay telephone service <a href="may">shall</a> may be sold, assigned or transferred by-the-holder-to-another-without-prior-Commission approval:--No-certificate-shall-be-used-as-collateral-for-any purpose.

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25-24.513 Application for Approval of Sale, Assignment or Transfer of Certificate.

- (1) A company desiring to obtain a certificate by sale, assignment or transfer from the holder thereof shall submit an application jointly with the certificate holder on Commission Form PSC/CMU 32 (1/87, amended / ), which is incorporated into this rule by reference. Form PSC/CMU 32 (1/87, amended / ), entitled "Application Form for Certificate to Provide Pay Telephone Service Within the State of Florida," was effective on January 5, 1987, amended on , 1989, and may be obtained from the Commission's Division of Communications.
- (2) An original and twelve (12) copies of the application shall be filed with the Division of Records and Reporting.
- (3) An application for a sale, assignment or transfer of a certificate will be granted if the Commission determines that such approval is in the public interest.
- (4) A certificate may be sold, assigned or transferred only as a whole.

## SUMMARY OF RULE

The amendment of Rule 25-24.512 will prohibit the transfer of pay telephone certificates. With the amendment of Rule 25-24.512, Rule 25-24.513 should be repealed because there is no longer a need for applications for transfer of certificates. The amendment of rule 25-24.510 corrects the word "advertises" to read "advertisements."

# SUMMARY OF HEARINGS ON THE RULE

No rulemaking hearing was requested or held in this docket.

## FACTS AND CIRCUMSTANCES JUSTIFYING THE RULE

The Florida Public Service Commission does not want an individual who is being sold, transferred, or assigned a pay telephone service certificate being led to believe that the certificate has some inherent monetary value for which the previous holder of the certificate should be compensated. Therefore, by the rulemaking proposed in this docket, the Commission intends to end the practice of transferring or assigning such certificates. The Commission will continue to issue new certificates.
