AMENDATORY ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

In Order No. 21100, issued April 24, 1989, we approved the stipulation of the parties regarding the appropriate service availability charges increasing those charges from from \$1,000 to \$1,200 for each new residential connection. However, we incorrectly stated that the gallonage charge was \$2.86 per gallon per day for all others. That Order should have stated that the gallonage charge for all others was \$4.61 per gallon per day. Therefore, we hereby amend Order No. 21100 to read, in two places on Page 3, under Paragraph No. 8, that the service availability gallonage charge for all others was increased from \$2.86 to \$4.61 per gallon per day.

Based on the foregoing, it is, therefore

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Order No. 21100 is hereby amended as set forth in the body of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that Order No. 21100 is hereby affirmed in all other respects.
