ORDER GRANTING UTILITY EXTENSION
OF TIME TO FILE DIRECT TESTIMONY

By Motion for Extension of Time filed by Sunshine Utilities November 15, 1989, the Utility has requested an extension of time to file its prefiled direct testimony in this proceeding. The deadline for filing such testimony was established by Order No. 21863 as November 16, 1989. The utility states that it will require additional time for the accounting firm that it has recently retained to assist it in its preparation of its case. In addition, there has been some discussion with our Staff regarding a possible settlement that had delayed the utility retention of this accounting firm. For these reasons, we find it appropriate to grant the utility's request. Therefore, the utility shall file its prefiled direct testimony by the close of business Wednesday, November 22, 1989.

Based on the foregoing, it is, therefore,

ORDERED that Sunshine Utilities is hereby granted an extension of time until November 22, 1989, to file its direct testimony in this proceeding.
