AMENDATORY ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

By Order No. 21796, issued August 28, 1989, this Commission ordered Utility Systems, Inc. (utility) to show cause why it should not be fined, pursuant to Rule 25-30.110, Florida Administrative Code, for late filing its 1987 annual report. A copy of Order No. 21796 was sent to the utility's official mailing address, a post office box in Seminole County, by Certified Mail. It was returned "unclaimed."

Since the utility failed to claim Order No. 21796, we believe that it is appropriate to have the Sheriff for Seminole County serve a copy of Order No. 21796 upon the utility at its street address. Accordingly, we hereby amend Order No. 21796 to require the utility to file a response to Order No. 21796 no later than the close of business twenty days from the date of this Order. All other provisions of Order No. 21796 remain unaffected by this Order.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Utility Systems, Inc. shall file a response to Order No. 21796 with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting, 101 East Gaines Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0870, by the close of business twenty (20) days from the date of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that Order No. 21796 is hereby affirmed in all other respects.
