# ORDER GRANTING PETITION TO INITIATE RULEMAKING PROCEEDINGS GOVERNING 900 SERVICES

#### BY THE COMMISSION:

By petition filed on January 15, 1991, the Attorney General and Public Counsel asked the Commission to adopt rules governing 900 services in order to protect the consumers of such services as well as telephone customers generally. Petitioners also proposed specific rules.

The petition alleged that abuses by some 900 providers, including unfair and deceptive sales, misrepresented services, and unclear cost of the call have resulted in victimization of consumers. The petition also alleges that phone bills do not inform customers of rights or of a mechanism to dispute 900 charges. In addition, blocking of 900 calls from the consumer's phone without charge is sought.

We concur in the need to adopt additional protection for consumers relevant to both 900 and 976 services. Therefore, we approve the initiation of rulemaking to address those issues.

In response to additional argument presented, we hold that the rulemaking process should be bifurcated to consider sections 1, 2(a), and 2(e) of the Attorney General's and Public Counsel's proposal on an expedited basis, leaving the remainder of the proposed rules for consideration thereafter.

We also note that granting this petition does not operate to adopt the rules suggested by petitioners. Those proposed rules are subject to the rulemaking process, including the review and suggestions of other interested participants.

In view of the above, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that the Petition to Initiate Rulemaking Proceedings Governing 900 Services filed by the Attorney General and Office of the Public Counsel is hereby granted.

Any party adversely affected by the Commission's final action in this matter may request: 1) reconsideration of the decision by filing a motion for reconsideration with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting within fifteen (15) days of the issuance of this order in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code; or 2) judicial review by the Florida Supreme

The notice of appeal must be in the form specified in Rule 9.900 (a), Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
