AMENDATORY ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

By Order No. PSC-92-0322-FOF-TL, issued May 11, 1992, we proposed requiring United Telephone Company of Florida (United) to implement a flat rate, nonoptional, two-way extended area service (EAS) plan for its Bonita Springs subscribers.

Shortly after issuance of the Order, it came to our attention that our description of the calling plan could be somewhat misleading. The plan we have approved provides for EAS between the Bonita Springs exchange and the Fort Myers, Fort Myers Beach, and Naples exchanges. It does not provide for toll free calling between all four exchanges as one of our descriptions might seem to imply. We note that this had no effect upon the survey process.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Order No. PSC-92-0322-FOF-TL is amended to the extent outlined in the body of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that Order No. PSC-92-0322-FOF-TL is affirmed in all other respects.
