AMENDATORY ORDER

On January 17, 1997, the Florida Public Service Commission issued Order No. PSC-97-0064-FOF-TP in Dockets Nos. 960847-TP and 960980-TP. However, due to scrivener's error, two amendments to that Order are necessary.

First, on Page 142 of the Order, the sentence preceding the heading "Rights-of-way" reads:

Thus, we find that GTEFL may charge AT&T and MCI a pro rata share of the TSLRIC for supplying the attachments requested in conformance with the FCC's allocation requirements.

The word "attachments" should be stricken and replaced with the word "facilities." The corrected sentence reads, "Thus, we find that GTEFL may charge AT&T and MCI a pro rata share of the TSLRIC for supplying the facilities requested in conformance with the FCC's allocation requirements.

Second, the following sentence shall be added to the end of the first full paragraph on page 34:

Where GTEFL did not provide nonrecurring cost studies, GTEFL shall provide TSLRIC cost studies within 60 days from the issuance of the Order.
