AMENDATORY ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 22, 1997, we issued Order PSC-97-1308-FOF-TL, requiring GTE Florida Incorporated to survey its Haines City subscribers for implementation of a non-optional, two-way extended area service plan that comported with the terms and conditions set forth in that Order. In the Order, we set forth rates that shall apply if the survey meets the criteria of Rule 25-4.063, Florida Administrative Tode. Due to a scrivener's error, however, certain rates indicated in Table B on page 11 were incorrect. Order No. PSC-97-1308-FOF-TL shall, therefore, be amended to reflect that the correct rate in Table B, line B-1, in the column "Present Rate," is \$26.25, and the correct rate on line B-1, in the column "New Rate," is \$35.56.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Order No. PSC-97-1308-FOF-TL is hereby amended to reflect the correct rates as set forth in the body of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that Order PSC-97-1308-FOF-TL is reaffirmed in all other respects.
