NOTICE OF PROPOSED AGENCY ACTION
ORDER CANCELLING INTEREXCHANGE
TELECOMMUNICATIONS CERTIFICATE

BY THE COMMISSION:

NOTICE is hereby given by the Florida Public Service Commission that the action discussed herein is preliminary in nature and will become final unless a person whose interests are substantially affected files a petition for a formal proceeding, pursuant to Rule 25-22.029, Florida Administrative Code.

Hospitality Communications Corporation d/b/a HCC Telemangement (HCC Telemangement), holder of Interexchange Telecommunications Certificate (IXC) of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 3164, has requested the cancellation of IXC Certificate No. 3164. HCC Telemangement has complied with the provision of Rule 25-24.474(2), Florida Administrative Code, by providing adequate notice in writing of its request for cancellation of its IXC certificate and by submitting its Regulatory Assessment Fees for 1998. Accordingly, we find it appropriate to cancel IXC Certificate No. 3164, effective December 31, 1998. HCC Telemangement shall return its certificate to this Commission.

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
Based on the foregoing, it is

In the absence of such a petition, this order shall become final and effective upon the issuance of a Consummating Order.

Any objection or protest filed in this docket before the issuance date of this order is considered abandoned unless it satisfies the foregoing conditions and is renewed within the specified protest period.
