ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

BY THE COMMISSION:

Petition, Broadslate Networks of Florida, ("Broadslate"), has requested permission to intervene in this proceeding. Broadslate states that its substantial interests will be affected and determined by the Commission in this proceeding. Broadslate intends to provide SDSL services throughout the State of In order to do so, Broadslate will be purchasing Florida. unbundled network elements ("UNEs") from BellSouth, including unbundled copper loops ("UCLs"). BellSouth, however, has proposed UCL non-recurring charges that border on being cost-prohibitive for Broadslate and are significantly higher than those of other incumbent local exchange carriers. As a provider of SDSL services, Broadslate is concerned that its rights and interests cannot be adequately represented by any other party in this docket. Moreover, Broadslate's participation in this docket will in no way unduly delay this proceeding.

Having reviewed the Petition, it appears that Broadslate's substantial interests may be affected by this proceeding. As a company serving customers in Florida with the intent of offering services that would require access to unbundled network elements, Broadslate has demonstrated that its substantial interests may be affected by this proceeding. Therefore, the Petition shall be granted. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.039, Florida Administrative Code, Broadslate takes the case as it finds it.

Therefore, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that the Petition for Leave to Intervene filed by Broadslate Networks of Florida, Inc., is hereby granted. It is further

A motion for reconsideration shall be filed with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting, in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code. Judicial review of a preliminary, procedural or intermediate ruling or order is available if review of the final action will not provide an adequate remedy. Such review may be requested from the appropriate court, as described above, pursuant to Rule 9.100, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
