AMENDATORY ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On November 26, 2002, we issued Order No. PSC-02-1656-PAA-TX requiring the removal of the local service provider freezes placed on customer lines by CAT Communications International, Inc. (CCI). The Order requires that the local service freeze be removed from the accounts of individuals who do not respond to CCI's inquiry and inform the company of their desire to retain the freeze. The customers are required to respond by December 15, 2002, and CCI must remove the local service freeze on the accounts of all customers who have not responded by that date. However, Order No. PSC-02-1656-PAA-TX erroneously indicates that the company must also remove the freezes on the accounts by December 15, 2002. Therefore, Order No. PSC-02-1656-PAA-TX is amended to reflect that the company is responsible for removing the freezes and must demonstrate that it has done so in its final report, which is to be filed with our staff 30 days after the date of the Consummating Order.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Order No. PSC-02-1656-PAA-TX is hereby amended to delete the requirement that CAT Communications International, Inc. remove freezes on the identified accounts by December 15, 2002. It is further

ORDERED that upon identification of the customers who have not timely returned the card requesting the retention of the local service freeze, CAT Communications International, Inc. shall submit local service requests to the appropriate local exchange company in

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

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order to remove the local service freezes on these accounts at no cost to the customers, and it must demonstrate that it has done so in its final report to be submitted to our staff 30 days after the date of the Consummating Order in this Docket. It is further

ORDERED that Order No. PSC-02-1656-PAA-TX is reaffirmed in all other respects.
