NOTICE OF PROPOSED AGENCY ACTION
ORDER GRANTING VOLUNTARY CANCELLATION OF
INTEREXCHANGE TELECOMMUNICATIONS
TARIFF AND REMOVAL FROM REGISTER

BY THE COMMISSION:

NOTICE is hereby given by the Florida Public Service Commission that the action discussed herein is preliminary in nature and will become final unless a person whose interests are substantially affected files a petition for a formal proceeding, pursuant to Rule 25-22.029, Florida Administrative Code.

Communitel, Inc. (Communitel) currently holds Registration No. TJ133, granted by the Commission on September 15, 1998, authorizing the provision of Interexchange Telecommunications Company service. The Division of the Commission Clerk and Administrative Services advised our staff that Communitel had not paid the Regulatory Assessment Fees (RAFs) required by Section 364.336, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-4.0161, Florida Administrative Code, for the year(s) 2002. Also, accrued statutory late payment charges for

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late RAFs payments for the year 2002 had not been paid. Communitel was scheduled to remit its RAFs by January 30, 2003.

Pursuant to Section 364.336, Florida Statutes, telecommunications companies must pay a minimum annual RAF of \$50 if the registration was active during any portion of the calendar year. Pursuant to Rule 25-4.0161 (2), Florida Administrative Code, the form and applicable fees are due to the Florida Public Service Commission by January 30 of the subsequent year. Pursuant to Section 350.113(4), Florida Statutes, the RAFs forms, for the period of January 1, through December 31, are mailed to entities at least 45 days prior to the date that payment of the fee is due. All entities that register receive a copy of our rules governing Interexchange Telecommunications service.

Communitel has since paid the 2002 RAFs, including accrued statutory late payment charges and requested voluntary cancellation of its certificate. Accordingly, we find it appropriate to cancel Communitel's Interexchange services tariff and remove No. TJ133 from the register, effective August 28, 2003. We are vested with jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Sections 364.336, 364.285, and 364.335, Florida Statutes.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Communitel, Inc.'s tariff and Registration No. TJ133 to provide Interexchange Telecommunications Carrier services is hereby canceled, effective August 28, 2003. It is further

ORDERED that is Communitel, Inc's tariff is canceled and it is removed from the Register in accordance with this Order, Communitel, Inc. shall immediately cease and desist providing Interexchange Telecommunications Service in Florida. It is further

ORDERED that the provisions of this Order, issued as proposed agency action, shall become final and effective upon the issuance of a Consummating Order unless an appropriate petition, in the form provided by Rule 28-106.201, Florida Administrative Code, is received by the Director, Division of the Commission Clerk and Administrative Services, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0850, by the close of business on the date set forth

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in the "Notice of Further Proceedings" attached hereto. It is further

ORDERED that in the event this Order becomes final, this docket shall be closed.
