AMENDATORY ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On August 10, 2004, we issued Order No. PSC-04-0783-CO-TI authorizing penalty assessments against Foxtel, Inc for apparent violations of Section 364.02(13), Florida Statutes and Section 364.336, Florida Statutes. However, due to a scrivener's error, the Order reflected that the Docket should be closed instead of remaining open for the requisite 14 days after issuance of the Order. Therefore, Order No. PSC-04-0783-CO-TI is amended to reflect the Docket shall remain open for the requisite 14 days after issuance of the Consummating Order pending receipt of the company's tariff, receipt of the company's current contact information and penalty payment, or referral of the penalty to the Department of Financial Services for further collection efforts.

Based on the foregoing, it is


