AMENDATORY ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 10, 2004, we issued Order No. PSC-04-1029-SC-TI, directing New Century Telecom, Inc. to show cause in writing why it should not be penalized for violation of Commission rules. However, due to a scrivener's error, the last sentence before the ordering paragraphs erroneously stated a new settlement offer must be received within 10 days of the issuance of the Order, which is in conflict with the intent of the Commission, as expressed in the third ordering paragraph, allowing 21 days for the submission of a new settlement offer. Therefore, Order No. PSC-04-1029-SC-TI is amended to reflect in the final sentence preceding the ordering paragraphs that the time within which a new settlement offer may be submitted is 21 days.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Order No. PSC-04-1029-SC-TI is hereby amended to reflect in the final sentence preceding the ordering paragraphs that the time within which a new settlement offer may be submitted is 21 days. It is further

ORDERED that Order No. PSC-04-1029-SC-TI is reaffirmed in all other respects.
