

Introduction

The purpose of this filing is to increase rates for Area Plus, Privacy Director and ISDN.

Revenue Information

The rate changes proposed in this filing will increase the Non-Basic Services – Residential Optional basket by 1%, which is within the allowable limits of the statute.

The ISMDI data link must be associated with a voice level hunt group assigned to the VMS subscriber. Incoming call data available from the CCS/SS7 network includes the number called, the type of incoming call (direct or forwarding due to busy or no answer), the forwarding number, and the calling number. The telephone numbers are provided as ten digit Directory Numbers.
- B. ISMDI provides the capability for the VMS provider to transmits data messages over the data link to the ISMDI host switch for use in delivering message waiting notification to VMS client users. These data messages will enable the VMS subscriber to activate or deactivate message waiting indicators (MWI) on VMS client station lines served by ISMDI compatible central offices.

Explanation of ODF terms and usage

The ODF is the blueprint for rate changes and includes key dates, contacts, rates and other information to enable the

General: Yellow highlighting is utilized to indicate changes since the last ODF was issued.

Description of Rate Changes Tab:

-File Date: formerly called the File Date. It is the date the Tariff is filed, shown on the tariff as "ISSUED".

-Tariff Effective Date: formerly called Effective Date. It is the date the tariff page becomes effective, based on state PSC approval. This is shown on the tariff page as "EFFECTIVE".

-Rate Effective Date: formerly called the Implementation Date. This is the date the rates actually go into effect. For example Business MemoryCall changes were made in AL over the weekend of 1-20-01. However, the billing cycle affected that weekend was the 19th, so the Rate Effective date for this change was 1-19-01. This is the date the rates changed for the customers. Sometimes an earlier date can be obtained by holding the processing of the Friday night cycle and processing it over the weekend. Holding the First Billing cycle to work over the weekend is not recommended. If needed, the Rate Database can issue OCCs so that an effective date can be retroactive back up to six months. This is usually only used for rate decreases

There is a special case of retroactive processing for usage, such as with DA. If the desired rate effective date is June 1, 2001, that would in fact be the Rate Effective Date and would be shown as such on the CRIS request. However, the IT work would not be completed until July 1, 2001. The first bill period in July would reflect the new rates based on usage beginning on June 1, 2001; i.e., the rates would be retroactive back to the Rate Effective Date.

Where there is a difference in the Rate Effective Date and the Tariff Effective Date, a footnote should be added to the tariff stating: Rates are effective month/day/year.
