ORDER CLOSING DOCKET

BY THE COMMISSION:

Magnolia Manor Water Works, ("utility"), is a small water utility serving the Magnolia Manor residential area composed of approximately fifty-four single family and mobile homes in Sumter County.


The utility applied for a staff-assisted rate case on October 17, 1988 and Docket No. 881089-WU was opened. On October 26, 1988 the owner of the utility filed a notice of abandonment pursuant to Section 367.165, Florida Statutes, and this docket was opened. On January 10, 1989, the circuit court appointed USA Utilities, Inc., as receiver of the utility. The receiver notified this Commission on January 18, 1989 of his intention to continue with the staff-assisted rate case.

The notice of abandonment and appointment of receiver are in accordance with the requirements of Section 367.165, Florida Statutes. The staff-assisted rate case continues in Docket No. 881089-WU. No further action is required in this docket.

Wherefore, in consideration of the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Docket No. 881417-WU is hereby closed.
