SECOND AMENDATORY ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

By Order No. 19534, issued June 20, 1988, this Commission required Utility Systems, Inc. (utility) to show cause why it should not be fined, pursuant to Rule 25-30.110, Florida Administrative Code, for late filing its 1986 annual report. A copy of Order No. 19534 was sent to the utility's official mailing address, a post office box, by certified U.S. Mail, but was returned "unclaimed".

We found what we believed to be the utility's street address and made a second attempt to serve Order No. 19534. In addition, by Order No. 19534-A, issued October 21, 1988, we directed the utility to respond to Order No. 19534 on or before November 10, 1988. These were also returned "unclaimed."

We have found another street address for the utility. Therefore, by this order, we hereby amend Order No. 19534 to state that the utility shall file a response to Order No. 19534 by the close of business twenty days from the date of this Order. All other provisions of Order No. 19534 remain unaffected by this Order.

It is therefore,

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Utility Systems, Inc., shall file a response to Order No. 19534 with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting, 101 East Gaines Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0870, by the close of business twenty (20) days from the date of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that Order No. 19534 is hereby affirmed in all other respects.
