## REVISED ORDER ESTABLISHING PROCEDURE

Topeka Group, Inc., filed a Motion for Extension of Time (the Motion) on June 23, 1989, requesting that it be given until July 5, 1989, to file its prefiled direct testimony in this matter. Order No. 21414, issued June 19, 1989, required that Topeka Group, Inc., as the applicant, file such testimony by June 27, 1989.
