**Dear Director:**

**Metro Line, Inc. respectfully requests reconsideration of the above referenced decision and Order based upon the following:**

- 1. The Commission's decision regarding Corporate Executive Offices (CEO) states that CEO not only failed to file its 1988 IXC annual report on time, but also failed to "file a timely response to Order No. 21425." CEO's response to that Order was filed more than thirty days beyond the due date. Wherean, Metro did respond to Order No. 21424 within the allotted time.**
- 2. The Commission's decision regarding Metro Line, Inc. states that "Metro should be treated the same as those companies that filed their annual reports late for the first time but did not respond to our offer of settlement." Nowhere in the voluminous file of letters and documents can there be found any mention of an "offer of settlement". Had Metro been apprised of such an offer it would have accepted it without hesitation.**

**In view of the foregoing, Metro Line, Inc. feels that the imposition of a \$2,000 fine is excessive in this case; that the violation of Rule 26-24.400 is no greater than that of CEO; and that any fine imposed upon Metro in excess of that imposed on CEO would be inappropriate and therefore, request reconsideration of the decision in this matter.**
