**INDUSTRIAL INTERVENORS'  
PRELIMINARY LIST OF ISSUES**

Air Products & Chemicals, Inc., American Cyanamid Company, Monsanto Company, Stone Container Corporation, Champion International Corporation and Exxon Company, USA, ("Industrial Intervenors"), through their undersigned attorney, file the following preliminary list of issues:

1. How should production costs be classified and allocated within the cost of service study?
2. How should transmission costs be classified and allocated within the cost of service study?
3. How should distribution costs be classified and allocated within the cost of service study?
4. How should any increase or decrease in revenue requirements be spread among the rate classes?
5. Is Gulf Power's proposed change to the PX minimum monthly bill reasonable, appropriate, and consistent with the other provisions of the rate?
6. Should Gulf's proposal to decrease the PXT on-peak energy charge and increase the off-peak energy charge be approved?

7. Should scheduled maintenance outages of a self-generating customer that are fully coordinated in advance with Gulf Power be subject to the ratchet provision of the SS rate?

8. Should the assumed 10% forced outage factor for self-generating customers that is built into the SS rate design be continued?

9. How should the reservation and nonfuel energy charges of the SS rate be set?

10. Should the SE rate be modified to allow additional opportunity sales to self-generating customers who have generating capacity which is available but less economic?
