




Statement on Caller ID


The Joint Task Force on State agency Law Enforcement Radio Communications is created by Chapter 282.1095 FS and is responsible for the creation of a common radio system to serve agency law enforcement. This system will feature state-of-the art trunked radio technology and will require interconnects with the public switched telephone network.


The Joint Task Force wishes to go on record and support the draft Department of General Services policy on Caller ID for the SUNCOM Network, which calls for implementation with the ability of the subscriber to block on either a per call or per line option. For security reasons in operating a multi-agency trunked radio system with talk groups that can transcend telephone company services boundaries, and uncertainty as to exactly how the Joint Task Force system will implement and use telephone interconnects, we believe this policy is a proper way to implement this feature.
