RE: DOCKET NO. 900825-EI - Petition by FLORIDA POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY for a declaratory statement with respect to its obligation to provide electric service to H.R. DRIGGERS in Columbia County.

Issue 1: Recommendation that the Commission not issue a declaratory statement in response to Florida Power and Light Company's petition. A declaratory statement is not the proper forum for resolving a territorial dispute.

MODIFIED - The Commission acknowledged that FPL has withdrawn their petition and directed that this docket be closed.

Issue 2: Recommendation that the Commission, upon its own motion, set a date for hearing to resolve the territorial dispute. The Commission has the authority, on its own motion, to identify and resolve the identification of a territorial dispute.



Issue 3: Recommendation that the Commission allow the companies no more than six months to bring a proposed agreement before the Commission. A progress report should be required within 60 days.

Issue 4: Recommendation that Suwannee Valley Electric Cooperative (SVEC) is the closest to the customer and should service the customer until the matter is resolved through a territorial agreement.

Issue 5: Recommendation that this docket remain open until a final territorial agreement is in place.

Issue 6: Recommendation that SVEC's request for Oral Argument be denied. There is no need for the granting of oral argument if the Commission dismisses the petition.
